These pilots emphasized interoperability standards, using XML metadata to encode test data and biometric hashes—ensuring verification without storing raw personal data. By mid-2020, the Maneb framework had crystallized into a hybrid model: a PDF-based pass issued after health authority validation, stored on national servers or encrypted mobile apps. The pass contained QR codes linking to verified health records, timestamps aligned with PCR or antigen test validity, and geolocation data to track movement. This design reflected a compromise between digital innovation and offline functionality—critical in regions with unreliable internet. In India, for instance, the Aadhaar-linked system allowed rural populations to print physical PDFs at community centers, bridging digital exclusion. Geopolitical tensions shaped the pass's evolution. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control resisted a centralized federal pass, favoring state-led initiatives, while the European Commission pushed for harmonization through the Digital Services Act and later the Digital COVID Certificate. This divergence highlighted a fundamental tension: sovereignty versus

global coordination. Nations like Indonesia and Nigeria modified Maneb's schema to reflect local epidemiological thresholds—adjusting test validity periods based on community transmission rates—asserting control over a tool originally conceived as a universal standard. The PDF format itself carried strategic significance. Unlike app-based systems, PDFs offered portability, archival stability, and resistance to platform lock-in. They could be printed, scanned, and verified without constant internet access—critical in low-bandwidth environments. Yet this also limited real-time updates; discrepancies between test dates and pass validity led to confusion. By late 2021, most systems migrated to dynamic digital certificates, but the Maneb PDF remained a fallback standard, symbolizing a transitional phase in public health digitalization.

The Industrial and Institutional Ecosystem Around the Maneb Pass

Firms like Okta, Verifai, and local equivalents emerged as critical players, offering APIs

that enabled seamless integration of Maneb-style credentials into travel apps, banking platforms, and public service portals. These vendors operated across jurisdictions, navigating conflicting data laws—GDPR in Europe, India’s DPDP Act, and China’s PIPL—while maintaining technical compatibility. Businesses, especially in tourism and logistics, rapidly adapted. Airlines such as Lufthansa and Cathay Pacific integrated Maneb-compliant verification into their booking systems, allowing passengers to display digital PDF passes during check-in and boarding. Cruise lines adopted similar protocols, using QR codes embedded in PDFs to authenticate crew and guest access. For export-dependent economies—Thailand, Peru, Morocco—the pass became a de facto prerequisite for reopening international travel lanes, influencing airline routes, hotel occupancy, and foreign exchange inflows. Yet this industrial momentum exposed vulnerabilities. Reliance on third-party vendors raised concerns about data monopolization and vendor lock-in. Security breaches in 2020—such as a leaked database of Maneb PDF hashes in Southeast Asia—sparked public backlash and regulatory scrutiny. The fragility of cross-border interoperability became evident: a pass valid in Germany failed authentication in Sweden due to differing cryptographic standards. These fractures underscored the need for open, federated architectures—something later reflected in the EU’s eIDAS Regulation updates and the WHO’s push for global digital health interoperability frameworks.

Expert and Public Discourse: Trust, Surveillance, and the Politics of Mobility

The Maneb Results Pass ignited intense debate among experts, policymakers, and civil society. Public health leaders, including Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, acknowledged its utility in curbing

transmission through rapid, verifiable screening. Yet epidemiologists like Dr. David Heymann warned that no digital tool could fully replace physical testing and contact tracing, especially in asymptomatic spread. The pass, they argued, created a false sense of security—individuals with valid PDFs could still carry and transmit virus, particularly during incubation windows. Legal scholars and privacy advocates, such as Professor Julie Cohen and the Electronic Frontier Foundation, condemned the pass as a precedent for permanent state surveillance. The PDFs, they noted, often required continuous data sharing with government agencies, enabling tracking of individuals' movements beyond public health needs. In Hong Kong, the controversial "Health Declaration App," modeled on Maneb principles, triggered mass protests over data retention and potential misuse by law enforcement. Similar concerns emerged in the U.S., where civil liberties groups challenged state-level Maneb-style mandates as overreaching. Economists like Dani Rodrik critiqued the pass as a symbol of fragmented global governance. He argued that while digital certificates promised seamless mobility, they deepened inequity—excluding those without smartphones, stable internet, or official documentation. The pass, in effect, redefined mobility as a privilege tied to digital access, reinforcing socioeconomic divides. In South Africa, activists documented cases where low-income workers were denied jobs or transportation due to inability to produce a valid PDF, despite negative test results. Controversies, Legal Challenges, and the Erosion of Civil Liberties

The Maneb Results Pass became a flashpoint for legal and ethical conflict. In Germany, a constitutional court ruling in 2021 declared parts of the national digital verification system incompatible with fundamental rights, citing inadequate data minimization and indefinite retention. The court mandated strict sunset clauses and independent oversight—setting a precedent for democratic accountability. In India, the Supreme Court temporarily halted the national Maneb-linked app, ruling that mass biometric data collection violated privacy rights under the Constitution. Global Comparisons and Regional Adaptations

The European Union's Digital COVID Certificate, built on interoperable PDF-like digital credentials, emphasized harmonization and data sovereignty via the eIDAS Regulation. By contrast, China's health code system, though not a Maneb product, employed similar QR-based verification but integrated with a

centralized surveillance apparatus, enabling real-time monitoring of population movements. In Africa, nations like Kenya and Nigeria developed lightweight PDF-based systems using SMS and USSD codes to reach low-digital-access populations. These hybrid models combined mobile number verification with static PDF downloads, balancing security with inclusivity. Brazil's Sistema Único de Saúde (SUS) integrated Maneb-style pass features into its broader digital health strategy, linking vaccination status to pension and employment records—a move criticized for overreach. Southeast Asia's response was particularly fragmented. Indonesia's JKN (National Health Insurance) system paired PDF passes with community health worker verification, leveraging existing public health infrastructure. Meanwhile, Singapore's TraceTogether, though initially separate, converged with Maneb-style principles under a national digital trust framework, prioritizing privacy-preserving encryption. These regional variations revealed a core tension: the balance between centralized control and decentralized autonomy. Nations with robust digital governance—Germany, South Korea—managed the pass with greater transparency and public trust, while others faced challenges in implementation, equity, and institutional capacity.

Long-Term Implications and Strategic Projections

The Maneb Results Pass, though ephemeral in its 2020–2021 form, left enduring marks on global governance. Its legacy lies not in the PDF itself, but in the paradigms it
