These reinterpretations reflect a broader trend: the novel’s archetype becomes a chameleon, absorbing regional anxieties while retaining its core metaphor of suppressed darkness. From an industry perspective, the graphic novel’s rise coincides with a crisis and reinvention in publishing. As print readership wanes, visual narratives attract younger, digitally native audiences, offering immersive engagement through sequential art. The commercial success of titles like **V for Vendetta** and **Persepolis** demonstrated the market’s appetite for politically charged, psychologically rich stories told visually. **Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde**—a work already steeped in moral ambiguity—thrives in this space. Publishers now commission adaptations not as mere fan

service but as cultural interventions, positioning the story as a lens for contemporary crises: mental health stigma, identity politics, and institutional corruption. The illustrated format amplifies emotional immediacy, bypassing interpretive distance and enabling readers to inhabit the horror of self-betrayal viscerally. Yet, the adaptation is not without risk. The compression of narrative, the reliance on visual shorthand, and the need for market appeal can dilute Stevenson's nuance. The original novel's epistolary and third-person limited perspective—crafted to sustain suspense and moral ambiguity—may be flattened in a graphic format where visual cues dominate. Critics argue that Hyde's symbolic weight risks becoming mere grotesquerie, reducing the allegory to spectacle. Moreover, in global markets, translations and cultural adaptations sometimes flatten the colonial subtext: Hyde's "otherness" may be sanitized, stripping the story of its critique of imperial hypocrisy. Educators in the UK and Canada have piloted curriculum modules using illustrated Jekyll and Hyde editions to teach ethics, mental health, and critical thinking. Meanwhile, philosophers debate whether the graphic version reinforces or challenges the deterministic view of human nature: does Hyde's autonomy reflect genuine free will, or is he the inevitable product of

social and psychological conditioning? The visual medium, with its interplay of gesture, gaze, and panel rhythm, subtly complicates this binary—Hyde’s presence feels both alien and disturbingly familiar, suggesting that darkness resides not in a shadow self, but in the corridors of the everyday. Geopolitically, the story’s endurance reflects universal anxieties about power, identity, and control—issues magnified in an era of surveillance capitalism, authoritarianism, and ecological collapse. The laboratory where Jekyll experiments mirrors modern research labs and biotech hubs, where scientific progress outpaces ethical oversight. Hyde’s emergence becomes a metaphor for unintended consequences, for systems designed to suppress but inevitably unleashing what they contain. In authoritarian regimes, the tale is sometimes co-opted as a cautionary fable about state control and individual rebellion; in liberal democracies, it warns of the erosion of empathy under neoliberal individualism. The graphic novel, distributed globally via digital platforms, transcends linguistic and cultural barriers, enabling cross-contextual dialogue about power and selfhood. Economically, the illustrated classic taps into the expanding licensed content economy. Studios, digital publishers, and independent artists collaborate to produce high-quality adaptations that generate revenue across media—comics, audiobooks, stage plays, even virtual reality experiences. This ecosystem creates value not only in sales but in brand longevity: Stevenson’s story, now a transmedia franchise, continues to generate interest across generations. For creators, particularly in emerging markets, such projects offer pathways to international visibility, challenging the Western-centric canon by infusing local aesthetics and concerns into a globally

recognized narrative. Looking forward, the trajectory of *Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde* illustrated classics suggests a convergence of literary, psychological, and technological forces. Artificial intelligence may soon enable personalized adaptations—where Hyde’s appearance and behavior evolve based on reader response, deepening psychological engagement. externalizes inner moral conflict. Yet Stevenson uniquely fused these traditions with contemporary anxieties: the rise of psychiatry, Darwinian evolution, and colonial exploitation. Hyde’s physical deformity—“a small, lank figure, with a sagacious eye and a thin, livid mouth”—was not merely grotesque but symbolic: a visible manifestation of the “unclean,” the “Other” that Victorian morality sought to exclude yet could not fully eradicate. The novella’s structure—a confined space (the London fog, the locked study), a trusted confidant (Mr Utterson), and a gradual descent into horror—mirrors the psychological

realism later emphasized by Freud. Stevenson's use of epistolary fragments, third-person immediacy, and unreliable narration creates suspense while inviting moral reflection. Hyde is never fully known; his nature is inferred through acts: a violent assault, a cryptic remark, a silhouette fading into shadow. This deliberate ambiguity allows readers to project their own fears, making the allegory timeless.

The Geopolitical and Economic Context of Duality: Empire, Modernity, and Control

Stevenson wrote during Britain's imperial zenith, a period when national identity was both celebrated and destabilized. The Empire spanned continents, yet within the metropole, social fractures deepened. The working class endured squalor and exploitation; the middle class clung to propriety; the elite grappled with guilt over colonial violence. **Jekyll and Hyde** reflects this internal contradiction: the respectable doctor, a figure of scientific authority, is undermined not by external corruption but by his own suppressed impulses. Hyde becomes the embodiment of imperial hypocrisy—the

face of progress that hides exploitation, violence, and moral decay. Economically, the Industrial Revolution redefined human experience. Hyde's “foreignness” and animalistic traits echo colonial tropes—yet Stevenson subverts them by making Hyde a product
