Colonial cartographers sought to fragment this organic geography, replacing oral boundaries with gridlines. Yet the *Kamakathigal* endured in collective consciousness, preserved through folk epics, temple rituals, and generational storytelling. The 19th-century Madras Presidency records document numerous land disputes resolved not by state courts, but by elders invoking *kamakathigal* oaths—testimony that these oaths remained legally cognizant in local memory long after colonial maps redrew the line.

Even in war, the *Kamakathigal* retained symbolic power. During the LTTE’s rise, the term resurfaced in poetry and resistance songs, transforming from a historical reference to a living covenant against erasure. The oaths of the *Kamakathigal* became not only legal instruments but acts of cultural defiance—a refusal to be reduced to a footnote in state narratives.

Geopolitical Context: From Colonial Fragmentation to Diaspora Resilience

British colonial rule dismantled traditional land tenure systems, replacing *kavu*-based stewardship with cash-crop plantations and centralized control. Post-independence, Sri Lanka's Sinhala-majority state further marginalized Tamil heartlands through discriminatory policies, while in Tamil Nadu, state-led development often bypassed hill districts, deepening regional inequities. The 1983–2009 civil war intensified this marginalization, as the *Kamakathigal* became a frontline—its villages caught in crossfire, its resources exploited, its people displaced.

Yet geography proved resilient. Even amid war, *Kamakathigal* communities maintained internal cohesion through cooperative farming, local councils, and clandestine trade. The highlands' inaccessibility became both a curse and a shield—protecting cultural memory while enabling survival. In Sri Lanka, the 2009 victory led not to integration, but to deeper alienation: land seizures, militarization, and the erasure of Tamil administrative presence.

The Tamil diaspora, dispersed across Canada, the UK, Australia, and the Gulf, has become the de facto steward of *Kamakathigal* identity.
