Publishers such as Breitkopf & Härtel in Germany and Schirmer in the U.S. established networks that turned sheet music into a transnational industry. This era coincided with the rise of the

middle class and the democratization of music education—piano ownership became a symbol of civic virtue and cultural refinement. Sheet music was not just sold; it was distributed as a tool of social mobility, embedded in school curricula, home practice routines, and even labor camp playlists. Yet beneath this veneer of accessibility lay structural inequities. This imbalance persists: a 2021 study by the International Music Score Library Project (IMSLP) found that less than 8% of digitized sheet music titles originate from African, South Asian, or Indigenous American traditions, despite oral traditions spanning millennia. The geopolitical dimension deepens when examining how sheet music became a tool of soft power. During the Cold War, the U.S. State Department funded the export of American piano music—especially jazz and classical repertoire—as part of cultural diplomacy. In Eastern Europe, underground networks smuggled Soviet-era compositions abroad, using sheet music as a covert channel of ideological exchange. The piano, once a symbol of bourgeois domesticity, now functioned as a mobile embassy, carrying national identity across borders. Even today, state-sponsored music programs in countries like South Korea and China explicitly use piano sheet music to cultivate global cultural influence, training youth in Western technique while promoting national compositions through

standardized scores. The digital age has disrupted this paradigm, yet not eradicated its underlying currents. The rise of digital sheet music platforms—MuseScore, IMSLP, and proprietary apps—has decentralized access, enabling composers from Lagos to Lima to publish and distribute works globally.
