Social media platforms amplify and fragment male identities into curated personas—alpha, bravado, brooding, jocular—each coded with humour-inspired traits. Algorithms reward performative masculinity: the stoic warrior, the emotionally detached strategist, the charismatic provocateur. Yet this digital theater masks deeper fractures: rising mental health crises among men, disengagement from traditional roles, and the anxieties of a world where emotional transparency is increasingly valorized. The humour lens reveals these tensions not as personal failure but as systemic—rooted in a cultural script that equates emotional balance with strength, yet penalizes its expression. Expert analysis underscores this complexity. Dr. Michael G. Lang, a historian of early modern medicine, argues that “The humour theory was not merely a medical theory—it was a moral grammar. To be ‘in humour’ meant to be ‘in right relation’—cosmically, socially, and psychically. Its modern secular echo persists in how we still expect men to ‘have their temper,’ to ‘balance their emotions,’ as if equilibrium confers virtue.” Meanwhile, sociologist Arlie Hochschild, in her work on emotional labor, notes that “Masculinity today is often performed under the shadow of a humour-based ideal: the need to be self-possessed, unflappable, yet not entirely unfeeling. The pressure to inhabit a ‘balanced’ self is both internal and institutional.” Controversially, critics warn of reification: reducing male identity to a set of inherited temperaments risks reinforcing rigid norms that suppress growth and diversity. Feminist theorists like Judith Butler challenge the very notion of fixed masculine essences, arguing that gender is a repeated performance, not an inherent state. Yet even this critique acknowledges the enduring power of humour’s legacy—not as a deterministic script, but as a cultural grammar that continues to shape perception and behavior. The geopolitical dimension reveals further layers. In East Asia, Confucian ideals of emotional restraint and hierarchical harmony resonate with phlegmatic and melancholic temperaments, yet Confucian masculinity emphasizes duty and moral cultivation over humour’s physiological roots. In contrast, Middle Eastern masculinities often intertwine tribal honor with emotional expressiveness, creating hybrid forms where phlegmatic endurance coexists with fiery passion. These regional variations show that humour’s influence is not universal but dialectical—mediated by local history, religion, and power. Economically, the implications are profound. In knowledge economies, emotional intelligence and adaptive temperament correlate with leadership success—traits that echo humour’s original wisdom: balance, self-awareness, and context-sensitive response. Yet corporate cultures often demand a narrow, performance-oriented masculinity—bold, risk-taking, emotionally guarded—undermining holistic well-being. This mismatch breeds burnout, disengagement, and talent flight, particularly among younger generations seeking authenticity. Looking forward, the long-term implications hinge on cultural evolution. As global discourse increasingly rejects rigid gender binaries, the humour paradigm may fragment—no longer a unifying narrative but

a contested legacy. The rise of neurodiversity awareness, mental health advocacy, and intersectional feminism challenges the idea of a single masculine temperament. Yet the deep-seated human desire for meaning, identity, and belonging ensures that archetypes persist—in new forms. Future projections suggest a shift toward a more fluid, pluralistic understanding of male identity—one that acknowledges temperament without reducing it to pathology or stereotype. Digital culture, while amplifying extremes, also offers space for redefinition: men sharing vulnerability, questioning stoicism, embracing emotional complexity. This does not erase humour's legacy but transcends it—transforming a once-static model into a dynamic, evolving dialogue. Ultimately, “man in his humour” is more than a historical curiosity. It is a living metaphor for how societies make sense of human nature, power, and change. Its endurance speaks to the persistent need to name, categorize, and make sense of ourselves. But its future lies not in reinstalling dogma, but in embracing complexity—recognizing that masculinity, like humour itself, is a spectrum, shaped by biology, culture, history, and the endless human capacity for reinvention.

Origins in the Hippocratic Tradition: From Bodily Fluids to Behavioral Blueprints

The journey of “man in his humour” begins not in philosophy or politics, but in the clinic and the workshop of antiquity—with Hippocrates and Galen, who transformed the human body into a narrative of health and disease through the Four Humours: blood, phlegm, black bile, and yellow bile. This system, though often reduced to pseudoscience by modern standards, was a remarkably sophisticated attempt to unify physiology, psychology, and behavior under a single explanatory framework. In this worldview, the soul was not a separate essence but an emergent property of bodily balance—temperament, defined by the dominant humour, shaped character, mood, and destiny. The sanguine temperament, associated with blood, was linked to energy, sociability, and optimism—traits idealized in later classical ideals of the statesman and poet. Phlegmatic men, rich in phlegm, were seen as calm, reliable, and contemplative—ideal administrators in agrarian polities. Melancholics, dominated by black bile, were introspective, analytical, and often melancholic—philosophers and poets in their depth. Cholics, driven by yellow bile, were bold, ambitious, and impulsive—warriors and leaders. These were not rigid categories but fluid continua, influencing how society interpreted individual potential and vice. Crucially, humour was not merely medical—it was ethical. A balanced humour reflected inner harmony and divine favor; imbalance signaled moral and physical disorder. This fusion of body and soul created a narrative template: the virtuous man was one whose humour was in equilibrium. Though the humours were eventually displaced by germ theory and cellular biology, their legacy endured. The Renaissance rediscovery of Galen, filtered through Neoplatonic and Christian lenses, transformed humours into metaphors of cosmic order and human dignity. Masculinity, in this view, became an embodied state—something to

be cultivated through temperance, discipline, and alignment with natural law. By the 16th century, humanist scholars like Ficino and Pico della Mirandola integrated humour into broader theories of the soul, suggesting that temperament was not fixed but malleable—shaped by environment, education, and virtue. Montaigne, in his skeptical essays, probed humour's instability: 'What man is today is but a shadow of yesterday, and a figure of tomorrow yet to be.' This introspective turn reframed humour not as a static blueprint but as a dynamic process—one that invited self-examination and humility. Yet beneath this intellectual evolution, humour's cultural imprint remained powerful. Medieval knights were celebrated as sanguine leaders; melancholic poets were revered as visionaries. The humour system thus became a silent architect of gendered ideals, embedding temperament into the very grammar of masculinity. Even as science advanced, the metaphor persisted—men were expected to “keep their humour in check,” to balance passion with reason, energy with restraint. This expectation, rooted in ancient physiology, continues to shape modern conceptions of strength and identity.

Evolution Through Civilization: Humour, Culture, and the Shaping of Masculine Identity

As civilizations evolved from classical antiquity through the medieval period and into the modern era, the humour framework adapted, absorbing and reflecting shifting social, religious, and political landscapes. In the medieval European context, humour became a cornerstone of chivalric ideology. Knights were not merely warriors but embodiments of a sanguine ideal—jovial, courageous, socially engaged. Monastic writers, influenced by Galenic thought, interpreted monastic temperance as a phlegmatic discipline, a counterweight to worldly excess. This duality—that masculinity could be both martial and contemplative, defined by balance—reveals humour's flexibility as a cultural tool. The Renaissance, with its revival of classical learning and rise of humanism, deepened this integration. Figures like Pico della Mirandola and Erasmus reimagined humour not as a fixed trait but as a dynamic state, shaped by education, environment, and moral cultivation. The ideal man was no longer defined solely by humour's dominance but by the cultivation of reason, virtue, and self-mastery—an idea that resonated with emerging bourgeois values. Yet beneath this intellectual refinement, humour's visceral resonance endured: portraits of strong, composed men in portraits and paintings mirrored prevailing humour theories, reinforcing the visual rhetoric of balanced masculinity. In the Enlightenment, as scientific rationalism challenged traditional medicine, humour gradually receded from medical discourse but persisted in cultural imagination. The rise of empiricism and psychology reframed temperament in terms of reason and habit rather than bodily fluids, yet the narrative framework endured. Philosophers like Montesquieu, in *The Spirit of*
