Moreover, institutional inertia persists: peer review remains anchored in reductionist norms, and funding cycles favor incremental over transformative research. Looking ahead, the most promising developments lie in cross-continental collaborations. The 2023 Global Relational Physics Initiative, hosted in Addis Ababa, brought together 47 nations to co-develop experimental tests of emergent gravity models derived from Anyakoha’s principles. Early results from a pan-African quantum interferometry network suggest anomalies consistent with relational emergence predictions—though definitive validation remains pending. In universities from Berlin to Bogotá, graduate programs now integrate New School Physics into core curricula, pairing it with computational modeling and participatory epistemology. The book’s greatest legacy may not be its conclusions, but its question: How do we reimagine physics not as a mirror of reality, but as a dialogue with it?
