This autonomy reflects a broader trend in Nigerian federalism: the assertion of regional agency in national institutions. Yet, when exam results reveal stark performance disparities—such as the persistent gap between urban and rural schools—state governments face acute pressure to justify both accountability and equity. Economically, the exam shapes human capital formation in a region where education is both a personal investment and a collective asset. Graduates of the Unified Exam feed into a

competitive labor market dominated by public service, private education, and emerging tech sectors. Ekiti's high tertiary enrollment rates—among the highest in Nigeria—attest to this linkage. Dr. Adebayo Ogunlade, a political economist at the University of Ibadan, argues that the exam “functions as both a bridge and a barrier.” It bridges by standardizing qualifications, enabling students to transfer across institutions and access national scholarship programs. Yet, as a barrier, it often replicates privilege: students from well-resourced schools benefit from better preparatory infrastructure, while those from underfunded communities face systemic disadvantages. “The Unified Exam does not level the playing field,” Ogunlade states, “it exposes its cracks.” This critique aligns with empirical data. Performance analysis from the Ekiti State Ministry of Education reveals that schools in the state's core urban centers—Ado-Ekiti, Ido-Osile, and Odo-Ekiti—consistently outperform rural counterparts by margins exceeding 30% in core subjects. Proctor reports confirm higher rates of proctoring failures, absenteeism, and technical glitches in peripheral schools, issues directly tied to infrastructure deficits. These disparities are not merely logistical; they reflect deeper investment gaps in public education, where teacher salaries, learning materials, and examination facilities remain chronically underfunded. Internationally, Ekiti's model invites comparison with unified examination systems in high-performing education jurisdictions.
