Looking forward, the long-term implications are profound. By 2030, the U.S. funeral market is projected to contract further, with digital platforms capturing 37% of new customer acquisitions. Traditional firms face three strategic choices: double down on legacy services with incremental tech integration, pivot toward holistic death care ecosystems (combining funeral services with estate planning, digital memorials, and grief support), or exit the market as cultural norms

shift toward de-institutionalized death practices. Baldwin Lee, in its final years, chose neither—surviving on legacy rather than reinvention.
