These initiatives, though small, demonstrate that resilience emerges not from control but from coexistence. Controversies abound. The use of genetically modified bees—proposed by biotech firms to enhance disease resistance or pollination efficiency—raises ethical and ecological alarms. Critics warn of unintended gene flow into wild populations, potentially disrupting evolutionary trajectories and reducing genetic diversity. Meanwhile, the rise of “citizen apiculture” in urban centers—driven by wellness trends and climate anxiety—has sparked debates over access, equity, and ecological impact. In Paris and New York, rooftop beekeeping has become a symbol of urban sustainability, yet without proper regulation, it risks displacing native pollinators or introducing pathogens into fragile urban ecosystems. Risks are manifold and interdependent. Climate change accelerates habitat loss and shifts flowering seasons, straining pollinator-plant synchrony.
