Kamasūtra-influenced vernacular traditions of medieval Karnataka. The *Kamasūtra* itself, composed in Sanskrit, found resonance in Kannada through localized adaptations—*Kāmāṅgakāvya*—that transformed abstract erotic philosophy into narrative form. Under colonial rule, when Kannada literary expression was surveilled and suppressed, erotic verse became a linguistic sanctuary. The *kāma kāvya* tradition absorbed *nāyikabhāsha*—women’s voice narratives—and reanimated them through metaphor, veiling critiques of caste hierarchy, gendered violence, and political subjugation beneath lilting descriptions of moonlit gardens and stolen glances. The *Kannada Kāma Kāvya Collective*, founded in 2018, now curates annual literary festivals and sponsors translations into English, Italian, and Malayalam, positioning the genre as a transregional cultural export. This shift reflects a broader recalibration: where once erotic literature was relegated to the margins, it now commands academic attention. Universities in Bangalore and Pune now include *kāma kāvya* in postgraduate courses on Indian literary theory, analyzing its use of *māyā* (illusion) and *anuvāda* (narrative framing) as tools of epistemic resistance. Industry experts note a paradigm shift in how *kāma kāvya* functions. Former literary critic Dr. Nandini Rao observes: “These stories are no longer just literary objects—they are cultural barometers. They reveal how Karnataka’s youth negotiate tradition and modernity, sacred and profane, private and public.” This duality is not contradiction but dialectic. The same verses that celebrate a

This hybridity reflects Karnataka's position as a linguistic crossroads—between Dravidian roots, Sanskrit inflections, and colonial-modern overlays. The genre's syntax often mimics the rhythm of spoken intimacy, with ellipses, breath pauses, and fragmented lines that mirror the unpredictability of desire. Expert interviews reveal that contemporary *kāma kāvya* has become a site of gendered negotiation. Female poets, once rare in the tradition, now dominate new publications. Their work rejects the male gaze, centering female agency not as object, but as subject. In a 2023 interview, poet and scholar Dr. Meera Nandini explained: "We write not to please, but to declare—our bodies, our yearnings, our right to speak. In doing so, we reconfigure desire as a form of epist
