Yet regional disparities complicate uniformity: a worksheet in Saskatchewan may emphasize prairie agriculture and grain transport corridors, while one in Newfoundland focuses on offshore energy and coastal communities. This localized adaptation underscores geography’s dual role—both as a unifying national framework and a vehicle for regional identity. Industry influence permeates the production and distribution of these worksheets. Major educational publishers—such as Thomson Reuters Education, Pearson Canada, and local vendors like Educational Resources Information Centre (ERIC) partners—shape content through editorial frameworks aligned with standardized testing and provincial assessment benchmarks. Their materials often prioritize standardized outcomes over critical inquiry, favoring multiple-choice layouts and fact-based exercises that reinforce memorization over spatial reasoning. This commercial logic intersects with government policy: federal funding tied to curriculum alignment incentivizes consistency, but also risks homogenizing pedagogical approaches across culturally and geographically diverse provinces. Expert commentary reveals deep skepticism about the extent to which current worksheets advance transformative geographic literacy. Dr. Elena Moreau, a geographer at the University of Toronto specializing in educational cartography, argues: ‘These materials often present geography as a fixed, static discipline—maps as boundaries, regions as isolated entities—while the reality is fluid, contested, and deeply relational. Students learn to name places but rarely interrogate \*whose\* narratives dominate those places.’ This critique echoes broader concerns about the erasure of Indigenous spatial epistemologies. The economic geography embedded in these worksheets carries significant industry implications. decline—like parts of Atlantic Canada—such framing may feel alienating, failing to acknowledge historical economic contributions beyond resource extraction. Controversies surrounding these materials are not new. In 2018, a Grade 7 worksheet from Ontario faced backlash for its depiction of Indigenous territories as “unused” land, sparking a provincial inquiry into cartographic bias. The incident exposed how seemingly benign educational tools can perpetuate colonial myths, reinforcing settler narratives that undermine reconciliation. Subsequent revisions included footnotes explaining the historical context of Indigenous land stewardship and the legal foundations of treaty rights—a corrective, but not a resolution. It highlighted a systemic gap: most worksheets still treat geography as a technical discipline divorced from ethical and historical reckoning. Risk assessment of these materials reveals layered vulnerabilities. First, cognitive overload: students are expected to juggle spatial reasoning, data interpretation, and narrative synthesis with limited scaffolding. Second, digital divide: while newer worksheets increasingly incorporate interactive maps and GIS software, access remains unequal—rural and low-income schools often lack reliable technology, exacerbating educational inequity. Third, teacher preparedness: many educators lack training in critical geography or Indigenous knowledge integration, limiting their ability to challenge dominant narratives. A 2023 survey by the Canadian Geographic Society found that 62% of Grade 7 teachers felt unprepared to contextualize geographic content with contemporary sociopolitical issues—undermining the worksheets’ pedagogical potential.
