Donor support, once a lifeline, declined after political tensions and governance concerns curtailed aid flows post-2008. Domestic revenue collection remains weak, averaging 12–14% of GDP, limiting the state's capacity to reinvest in education. Meanwhile, global trends in privatization and user fees—observed in countries from Nigeria to South Africa—have normalized the idea of education as a market good, even amid constitutional guarantees of free schooling.
