Moreover, integration with digital platforms allows for companion content: annotated readings, scholarly essays, and discussion guides, transforming the

audiobook from a passive listening experience into an interactive learning ecosystem. Expert commentary on the audiobook's design reveals a nuanced understanding of its audience.
