In the U.S., the 1970s saw growing public skepticism fueled by accidents—Three Mile Island (1979)—and rising costs, undermining confidence in large-scale reactor deployment. In contrast, France's centralized governance enabled sustained investment and public trust, achieving near-universal acceptance of nuclear power through transparent policy and economic integration. The geopolitical dimension deepened with the Cold War. The Soviet Union pursued a parallel nuclear trajectory, prioritizing fast breeder reactors and military applications, integrating nuclear engineering into its industrial-military complex. Meanwhile, the Non-Proliferation Treaty (NPT, 1968) sought to regulate technology transfer, but fissile material access remained a persistent concern. Export controls and safeguards became critical, shaping how nuclear engineering knowledge diffused globally—often selectively, sometimes illicitly. Economically, nuclear engineering's evolution mirrored shifting energy markets. The 1970s oil shocks reinvigorated interest in nuclear as a stable, carbon-free alternative, prompting international coalitions—such as the OECD's Nuclear Energy Agency—to support research and deployment. Yet the 1986 Chernobyl disaster shattered the illusion of infallibility. Beyond its immediate human toll, Chernobyl exposed systemic failures: flawed RBMK reactor design, inadequate safety culture, and weak regulatory oversight. The incident triggered a global reevaluation, slowing expansion in Europe and catalyzing reforms in operational safety, transparency, and emergency preparedness. The post-Cold War era saw nuclear engineering adapt to new realities. The collapse of the Soviet Union left legacy reactors in disrepair, prompting international efforts—through initiatives like the Nunn-Lugar Cooperative Threat Reduction program—to secure and decommission weapons-usable materials. Meanwhile, emerging economies, particularly China, India, and South Korea, embraced nuclear energy as a pillar of development. China's aggressive nuclear expansion, driven by a state-led model, now includes indigenous designs like the Hualong One and advanced molten salt reactors, signaling a shift toward technological sovereignty. Today, nuclear engineering stands at a crossroads of innovation and legacy. Passive safety systems, digital instrumentation and control, and probabilistic risk assessment have transformed reactor reliability. The geopolitical landscape further complicates the field's trajectory. In an era of strategic competition, nuclear technology is both a tool of energy security and a vector of influence. Russia's export of VVER reactors to Turkey, Egypt, and Bangladesh underscores nuclear diplomacy's role in soft power projection. Meanwhile, U.S. and European firms face pressure to compete with state-backed Chinese and Russian exporters, who often offer financing packages tied to geopolitical alignment. Looking forward, nuclear engineering's future hinges on three interlocking trajectories: technological innovation, institutional adaptation, and societal trust. Small modular reactors (SMRs), with their factory-built modules and enhanced safety, promise to reduce costs and accelerate deployment—particularly in regions with limited grid infrastructure. Fusion energy, though still experimental, offers a transformative vision: reactors that produce minimal waste, no long-lived isotopes, and no proliferation risk. Projects like ITER and private ventures such as Commonwealth Fusion Systems illustrate growing momentum, though commercial viability remains decades away. Equally critical is the evolution of governance. The IAEA's role continues to expand, promoting harmonized safety standards and robust safeguards. Yet fragmented national policies, inconsistent regulatory frameworks, and public resistance in key markets threaten cohesion. The success of nuclear energy in the climate era may depend not only on technical feasibility but on the ability to rebuild trust through transparency, equity, and inclusive decision-making. Experts agree: nuclear engineering's renaissance depends on its capacity to learn from history, innovate responsibly, and align with global sustainability goals. As the world seeks to decarbonize, nuclear's role as a reliable, high-capacity low-carbon source is increasingly recognized—yet its integration will require not just engineering excellence, but political will, economic foresight, and a renewed commitment to ethical stewardship.

Modern reactor designs have evolved into highly specialized systems, each optimized for distinct performance criteria. Pressurized Water Reactors (PWRs), accounting for over 60% of global nuclear capacity, use enriched uranium fuel rods immersed in high-pressure water, serving as both moderator and coolant. Passive safety systems in newer PWRs—such as gravity-driven emergency core cooling—reduce reliance on active mechanical
