Digitization, while protective, risks detaching documents from their material context, reducing history to data points. Ethically, the Menagerie exposes tensions between transparency and privacy: declassified CIA memos may reveal covert atrocities, but also expose personal identities. In 2021, the release of U.S. torture interrogation logs sparked global debate—was the paper's exposure a victory for accountability or a violation of human dignity? Looking ahead, the Menagerie may evolve into hybrid forms. Blockchain technology is being tested to authenticate digital copies of paper records, linking physical and digital realms securely. Augmented reality interfaces could allow users to 'turn' fragile pages virtually, preserving originals while enabling global access.
