Its scoring logic privileges certain forms of storytelling—linear, investigative, audience-engaged—while marginalizing oral traditions, communal narratives, or forms of expression rooted in non-

Western epistemologies.” This critique has prompted calls for regional adaptations, particularly in Africa and Latin America, where local media councils now pilot modified scoring systems informed by indigenous communication practices.

Industry Impact and the Professionalization of Journalism

Within the broadcast journalism profession, the Manual has played a pivotal role in shaping standards of practice and education. Media schools incorporate its criteria into curricula, and professional organizations use it as a benchmark for awards, grants, and accreditation. Its influence extends to hiring: newsrooms increasingly reference the Manual when evaluating talent, especially for long-form and public interest reporting. Economically, the Manual has helped structure funding models. Donors and public broadcasters tie support to alignment with its principles—prioritizing in-depth reporting over clickbait content. This has incentivized newsrooms to invest in investigative units and community engagement, even amid shrinking budgets. Yet this dependency has also raised concerns about mission drift: when survival hinges on scoring well on a rubric designed for a different era, do journalists risk tailoring stories to fit the Manual’s expectations rather than serving their audiences authentically? As media continues to redefine itself, the Manual’s greatest value may not lie in scoring, but in prompting the question: what does it mean to tell stories that matter?
