Author Amara Nascimento, a former farmworker from Pará, Brazil, spent seven years embedded in the berry fields of Washington State, documenting the lives of Indigenous and migrant pickers whose labor sustains supermarkets from Oslo to Seoul. Her breakthrough came not through academic journals, but through the quiet testimony of women she met

Nascimento wove them into a human mosaic, revealing how structural violence is reproduced not through overt cruelty alone, but through policy, language, and the silence of consumers. Migrant pickers, often undocumented or on temporary visas, lack legal protections, making them vulnerable to exploitation. In 2021, a report by Human Rights Watch documented systemic abuse in Sonoran fields: wage withholding, threats, and forced confinement—all enabled by a regulatory framework that prioritizes trade efficiency over labor rights. Europe, particularly France and Spain, has seen a reversal: while it once imported berries, recent climate instability and rising labor costs have spurred investment in domestic greenhouse production. Yet, this shift raises new ethical questions. Hydroponic farms, though climate-controlled, rely on migrant labor from North Africa, often under similar precarious conditions. The berry economy thus reflects a dual geography—both expansion into new frontiers and the reconfiguration of old ones—where geography is inseparable from power. This global system is not static. Climate change is altering growing seasons and expanding viable zones. In Chile, rising temperatures are pushing

strawberry cultivation southward, disrupting traditional labor patterns. In California's Central Valley, prolonged droughts are straining water resources, forcing growers to negotiate with both farmers and migrant communities over access. transformation: from passive consumer to active participant in ethical consumption. Yet resistance persists. Agribusiness lobbies in Brazil and Mexico have pushed back against stricter regulations, framing them as barriers to competitiveness. In Senate hearings in 2025, industry representatives argued that enhanced labor protections would inflate food prices and harm small producers. This tension reflects a deeper ideological conflict: between a model of profit-driven efficiency and one rooted in human dignity.

Expert Perspectives: The Intersection of Labor, Ecology, and Justice To fully grasp **The Berry Pickers**, one must engage with the voices of scholars, activists, and policymakers who have shaped—and challenged—its narrative. Their resilience is political.” Osei points to the rise of digital platforms where berry pickers share real-time updates on working conditions, bypassing traditional media gatekeepers. These networks, he argues, represent a new frontier of labor organizing—decentralized, networked, and rooted in lived experience. Legal scholars like Professor Mira Desai of Harvard Law have analyzed the book’s implications for

international labor law. Desai notes that **The Berry Pickers** “exposes the gaps in the ILO’s Convention 149 on migrant workers, which remains weakly enforced in key producing countries.” She advocates for binding corporate accountability laws, modeled after the EU’s Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive, requiring companies to audit their entire supply chains for labor abuses. In Southeast Asia, rice farming—though more politically entrenched—shares parallels: seasonal labor, environmental degradation, and migrant flows. These sectors, often dominated by foreign investment, replicate patterns of low wages and environmental strain seen in Latin America and the U.S. West Coast. Yet African producers increasingly leverage transnational networks and digital platforms to demand fairer terms, echoing the solidarity modeled in *The Berry Pickers*. Long-Term Implications: The Future of Labor, Land, and Consumption Looking ahead, *The Berry Pickers*

points toward a transformation in how global food systems are perceived and governed. The book has catalyzed a shift from “food security” to “food justice”—a paradigm that centers labor rights, ecological sustainability, and equity. Technological innovation may play a dual role.
