spirits and land-based rituals, where shamans acted as conduits between worlds. These early models established a pattern: power perceived as divine was not abstract—it was tangible, performative, and deeply social. It conferred legitimacy, guided collective action, and structured power itself. By the medieval era, institutional religion had codified access to this power. The Christian mystical tradition, exemplified by figures like Hildegard of Bingen and Meister Eckhart, emphasized inner transformation as a pathway to divine union. Yet, such experiences remained elite, mediated through monastic discipline and ecclesiastical authority. The Reformation shattered this monopoly, democratizing access through the doctrine of the "priesthood of all believers," but simultaneously politicizing it. The rise of nation-states co-opted spiritual authority—royal coronations became sacral performances, divine right justified conquest, and religious fervor fueled wars that redrew continents. Supernatural power, once the domain of saints and sages, became entangled with geopolitics: the Crusades were not merely religious campaigns but economic ventures masked in divine mandate; colonial expansion was sanctified through apocalyptic visions of Christian civilization's global mission. The 19th and 20th centuries accelerated this transformation. The Enlightenment's skepticism fractured traditional certainties, but simultaneously, new forms of spiritual power emerged. The rise of Pentecostalism in early 20th-century America, born from fractured revivalism, redefined divine power as immediate and experiential—manifested through glossolalia, healing, and prophetic utterance. This was not a retreat from power, but a reconfiguration. Simultaneously, global conflicts and ideological struggles—from the Russian Revolution to the Cold War—spawned movements claiming supernatural insight as revolutionary force, from Bolshevik millenarianism to liberation theology in Latin America. Power, once legitimized by blood or dogma, now claimed legitimacy through spiritual authenticity and charismatic authority.

Today, in an era of digital saturation and cognitive fragmentation, the supernatural power of God is both diluted and amplified. The internet has decentralized spiritual authority, enabling decentralized, global networks of practitioners—from online meditation teachers to AI-generated prophetic content—blurring sacred from synthetic. Yet, amid secularism's rise, paradoxical revivals occur: the global surge in non-denominational spiritual seeking, the commodification of mindfulness as a secular power practice, and the rise of "spiritual but not religious" identities that demand direct, unmediated encounters with the divine. This tension—between institutional control and individual transcendence—defines the current epoch.

Geopolitical Currents: Power, Propaganda, and the Sacred

The geopolitical dimension of divine power is no longer confined to temples or churches; it permeates statecraft, conflict, and soft power. In contemporary authoritarian regimes, spiritual legitimacy remains a cornerstone of governance. In Saudi Arabia, the state's custodianship of Islam's holy sites is not merely symbolic—it is a source of global religious authority, shaping policy, funding, and international influence. Similarly, in Iran, the fusion of Shi'a theology with revolutionary ideology positions clerical power as a conduit of divine justice, rendering political legitimacy inseparable from sacred mandate. In democratic societies, the invocation of divine power often serves as a strategic discourse. Politicians cite divine guidance to legitimize decisions—from war declarations framed as "God's will" to civil rights movements anchored in moral righteousness. Yet, this instrumentalization risks reducing transcendent experience to rhetorical tool, eroding genuine spiritual depth. The tension is acute: when power claims to emanate from God, who defines that authority? In Nigeria,

religious leaders wield immense influence over electoral outcomes, blending prophecy with political mobilization. In Myanmar, Buddhist nationalist movements have weaponized sacred narratives to justify violence, illustrating how divine power can be perverted into instruments of exclusion and terror. Economically, spiritual power has become a commodified asset. The global wellness industry—valued at over \$1.3 trillion—thrives on the promise of transcendent experience, with yoga studios, retreat centers, and digital meditation apps monetizing inner transformation. This commercialization reflects a deeper societal yearning: in an age of alienation and precarity, people seek tangible encounters with the sacred, often through structured, market-driven pathways. Yet, critics warn of spiritual bypassing—where technology offers the illusion of enlightenment without confronting systemic injustice. The power once exercised through communal ritual now flows through screens, raising questions about authenticity, accessibility, and the commodification of transcendence. Industry-wise, religious institutions have adapted with remarkable agility. Mega-churches in the Global South blend Pentecostal fervor with entrepreneurial branding, attracting millions through multimedia worship and prosperity theology. Meanwhile, mainline denominations grapple with declining membership, responding with hybrid models—online services, social justice advocacy, and interfaith dialogue—seeking to remain relevant in a world where spiritual authority is increasingly diffuse. The rise of “spiritual influencers” on platforms like YouTube and TikTok further disrupts traditional hierarchies, enabling self-proclaimed conduits of divine insight to reach global audiences, bypassing institutional gatekeeping. This shift has profound implications. As spiritual power becomes decentralized, so too does its meaning. Authority is no longer inherited or ordained but earned through personal testimony, digital reach, or perceived authenticity. This democratization fosters pluralism but

also fragmentation—where competing claims of divine insight compete for attention, often without shared ethical frameworks. The result is a global spiritual marketplace, where power is both liberated and destabilized.

Expert Perspectives: From Neuroscience to Theology

The scientific exploration of spiritual power has yielded compelling, if contested, insights. Neuroscientific studies using fMRI and EEG reveal that deep meditation, prayer, and ritual induce measurable changes in brainwave patterns—theta and alpha states associated with heightened introspection, emotional regulation, and a sense of unity. Researchers at institutions like MIT and the University of Wisconsin-Madison have documented increased gamma synchrony during peak mystical experiences, suggesting a neurobiological correlate to transcendent states. Yet, correlation does not imply causation: these states may reflect altered cognition, not divine encounter per se. Dr. Andrew Newberg, a leading neuroscientist in the field, argues that while brain activity underlies spiritual experience, it does not negate its reality. “The brain mediates the experience,” he writes, “but the content—feeling connected, transcendent, aware beyond self—is not reducible to neurons alone.” His work on Sufi and Buddhist practitioners highlights how ritual, intention, and belief shape neural pathways, creating a feedback loop between mind and spiritual insight. Theologically, scholars grapple with reconciling ancient revelations with modern epistemology. Dr. Karen Armstrong, theologian and historian, posits that all major religious traditions share a core: the “prophetic moment,” where individuals encounter the sacred not through dogma, but through direct, ineffable contact. For her, divine power is not a static entity but a dynamic force activated through human openness—what she calls the “spiritual impulse”

embedded in human consciousness. Contrast this with critical perspectives: Dr. Elaine Pagels, historian of religion, warns against romanticizing mysticism. “Spiritual experiences have always been interpreted through cultural lenses,” she notes. “The same state of consciousness may be called ecstasy in one tradition and demonic possession in another. Power, in all forms, is shaped by power structures—gender, race, class.” This critical lens underscores the danger of spiritual authority becoming a tool for exclusion, especially when charismatic leaders claim exclusive access to divine truth. In the Global South, where religious syncretism thrives, these tensions play out vividly. In Brazil’s Candomblé, practitioners invoke orixás with profound spiritual intensity, blending African cosmology with Catholic symbolism. Here, divine power is communal, embodied in rituals that affirm identity and resistance. Yet, such practices often face marginalization, revealing how spiritual legitimacy is contested in postcolonial societies where Western epistemologies dominate.

Risks, Controversies, and the Fragility of Sacred Authority

The pursuit of divine power carries significant risks, particularly when institutionalized or instrumentalized. One major danger is the cult of personality—where individuals claim exclusive access to God, fostering dependency and authoritarian control. Historical examples abound: Jim Jones, Charles Manson, and more recently, digital gurus promoting apocalyptic cults. These figures exploit the human yearning for transcendence, channeling spiritual energy into systems of manipulation, fraud, and violence. Even within mainstream faiths, the concentration of spiritual authority can enable abuse. The Catholic Church’s handling of sexual abuse scandals reveals how institutional power, when detached from accountability, corrupts divine mandate. Similarly, the

politicization of religion in Sri Lanka and Myanmar has turned spiritual communities into battlegrounds, where divine claims justify ethnic cleansing. Another risk lies in the epistemological ambiguity of spiritual experience. Without shared criteria for validation, subjective revelation becomes vulnerable to manipulation. The rise of “spiritual self-help” often blurs the line between genuine transformation and psychological self-fulfillment, risking spiritual bypassing—where individuals use transcendent narratives to avoid confronting trauma or social injustice. Moreover, in secular democracies, the invocation of divine power can undermine pluralism. When religious leaders assert exclusive truth claims, they challenge the secular social contract, threatening the inclusion of non-believers and
