South Africa’s Truth and Reconciliation Commission, though controversial, demonstrated that acknowledging suffering—even when incomplete—can break cycles of vengeance. Yet they caution against mythologizing the past, warning that selective memory can fuel new exclusions. Law Seven: Economic interdependence reduces incentives for war, but only when structured equitably.
