Gräfen, a marginal figure in academic astrology circles, had compiled a fragmented synthesis of Hellenistic natal charts, Eastern karmic concepts, and early psychoanalytic theory. His work emerged from the intellectual ferment of interwar Europe—where spiritual inquiry collided with scientific rationalism, and where the collapse of empires bred a hunger for meaning beyond borders. Past life astrology, as Gräfen documented, was not a new revelation but a reconfiguration—an alchemical transformation of ancient ideas into a narrative of personal destiny.
