The syllabus split—between foundational Indian national frameworks, Saudi national curriculum mandates, and globally recognized international standards—reveals far more than educational bureaucracy. It exposes the fault lines where heritage, geopolitics, and market logic intersect. The origins of this rupture lie not in classrooms alone, but in decades of shifting demographics, fiscal pressures, and the quiet but relentless push by Saudi Arabia to indigenize its education system under Vision 2030. For over four decades, Indian international schools in Jeddah and across the Kingdom served as critical nodes of cultural continuity for Saudi Arabia's South Asian diaspora—over 3 million Indians residing in the Kingdom, many employed in energy, construction, healthcare, and academia. These institutions offered not just academic continuity but a sense of familiarity in a foreign environment. Yet, by the early 2020s, a confluence of pressures began to strain the sustainability of the existing model. The Indian government's growing emphasis on standardized national education—embodied in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020—prioritized multilingualism, STEM integration, and digital literacy, often at the expense of regionally specific curricula. Simultaneously, Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030, with its \$700 billion investment in education, sought to reduce dependency on foreign schools by mandating alignment with the Saudi National Curriculum (the Common Curriculum for expatriate schools), which emphasizes Arabic language, Islamic studies, and national history. This created a constitutional tension: how could a school simultaneously serve as both a cultural enclave for Indians and a compliant participant in Saudi Arabia's nation-building project? The school's governing body, a consortium of Indian expatriate parents, school administrators, and diplomatic stakeholders, initially resisted full integration. But mounting fiscal pressures—rising operational costs, teacher retention challenges, and fluctuating enrollment—forced a strategic reassessment. The decision to break away from the original Indian curriculum was not made in isolation; it emerged from behind closed negotiations between the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Saudi Ministry of Education officials, and the school's board, mediated by international education consultants specializing in cross-border accreditation. The resulting syllabus was not a binary shift to Saudi or Indian standards, but a layered synthesis—what the school's director, Dr. Meera Nair, described as a “dialectical curriculum.” Core subjects such as mathematics and science retained CBSE's rigorous structure but were infused with localized case studies—Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) projects, Gulf labor market dynamics, and environmental challenges specific to the Red Sea region. History and civics integrated Indian constitutional principles with Saudi perspectives on Islamic civilization and Gulf cooperation. Literature courses included Hindi epics, Urdu poetry, and Saudi poetic traditions, fostering a polyphonic national identity. Economically, the breakup reflected deeper structural shifts. The Indian education export sector, valued at over \$12 billion and employing 1.2 million people, had grown

complacent in the Jeddah market—relying on a stable but increasingly saturated expatriate demand. Saudi Arabia, by contrast, aimed to localize its education supply chain, reduce import dependency, and create a self-sustaining system that could serve not just Indians, but other nationalities seeking an Indian-style international education. The new syllabus, therefore, was as much a commercial maneuver as an educational one: it enabled the school to maintain enrollment while aligning with Saudi licensing requirements, thus securing long-term operational viability. Yet the transition was fraught with controversy. Indian education experts criticized the dilution of CBSE’s hallmark—consistency in assessment and international recognition—arguing that hybrid models risked undermining academic credibility. Parents expressed anxiety over curriculum fragmentation: would their children maintain alignment with Indian university admissions, especially those in engineering and medicine, where global benchmarks remain CBSE- or state board-dependent? Critics also raised concerns about political instrumentalization: could a school’s curriculum truly remain neutral when forced to navigate dual ideological frameworks—India’s secular federalism and Saudi Arabia’s Wahhabi-influenced education doctrine? From a geopolitical lens, the syllabus breakup exemplifies a broader trend: the weaponization of education as soft power infrastructure. India’s Ministry of External Affairs had, since 2014, actively promoted CBSE schools abroad as instruments of cultural diplomacy, with over 120 Indian international schools now operating across 45 countries. But Saudi Arabia’s push signals a counter-movement—one where education policy becomes a vector of regional influence. By demanding alignment with its national curriculum, Saudi Arabia asserts educational sovereignty while selectively adopting elements of India’s pedagogical strengths—particularly in multilingualism and holistic learning—without full ideological surrender. Industry analysts note this as a paradigm shift in expatriate education. Historically, Indian schools thrived by exporting a standardized, exam-focused model. Now, they must compete not just on academic rigor but on cultural adaptability and geopolitical alignment. The breakup underscores a growing bifurcation: schools either fully localize to host-country demands or maintain hybrid models that straddle multiple systems—a strategy increasingly costly and complex. Expert commentary reveals a schism in pedagogical philosophy. Dr. Arjun Mehta, a professor of international education at Jawaharlal Nehru University, frames the change as a “curriculum tectonic shift”: “We are witnessing the collapse of the monolithic ‘Indian curriculum’ export model. Education is no longer a one-way transmission of values but a negotiation between competing national narratives. Schools in Jeddah are now laboratories of cultural negotiation.” Risks abound. Regulatory scrutiny from both Indian and Saudi authorities has intensified, with compliance audits becoming routine. Financial sustainability remains precarious: the school’s new model requires dual certification—CBSE and Saudi—doubling administrative overhead while enrollment volatility threatens cash flow. Moreover, teacher training has become a critical bottleneck; educators must now navigate dual curricula, cultural expectations, and language demands, often without adequate support. Globally, parallels emerge. In the UAE, Dubai International Academy recently adopted a similar dual-track model, blending international baccalaureate standards with Emirati national content. In Nigeria, Indian schools in Lagos have faced community backlash over curriculum shifts perceived as cultural compromise. Yet Saudi Arabia’s approach stands out for its top-down enforcement—unlike the more decentralized, parent-driven reforms seen elsewhere. Looking forward, the long-term implications are profound. The

syllabus breakup may redefine the very concept of “international education” in the Gulf. Schools will increasingly serve as nodes in a multipolar educational ecosystem, where cultural authenticity and political compliance are traded as strategic assets. For India, the challenge lies in preserving academic excellence while adapting to host-country realities—ensuring that its global schools remain engines of soft power, not casualties of geopolitical friction. The Jeddah school’s journey—from a confident conveyor of Indian educational values to a contested site of cultural negotiation—offers a microcosm of 21st-century globalization: fluid, conflicted, and deeply strategic. As nations weaponize education not just for economic gain but for identity affirmation, the breakup of syllabi in Jeddah will be remembered not as a single event, but as a turning point in the global struggle to define what it means to educate across borders.
