She documented the erasure of women's lives under fundamentalist governance, not through a theological critique of Islam, but through a human rights framework that foregrounded agency and dignity. Yet her portrayal remained selective: she highlighted Afghan women's resilience without fully interrogating the diverse, often suppressed, expressions of Islamic identity within the country. This selective visibility, while politically charged, revealed a nascent effort to represent

Muslim women not as monolithic victims but as subjects with their own cultural and religious narratives. Jolie's self-identification with Islam, though never formal conversion, has been a subject of intense scrutiny. In interviews, she has described feeling "deeply connected" to Islamic values—particularly justice, compassion, and the sanctity of life—without subscribing to any institutional orthodoxy. This distinction is critical: she does not claim to be Muslim in a religious sense, but rather identifies with what she

terms a “spiritual affinity” to Islamic ethics. This positioning allows her to navigate sensitive intersections between global citizenship and religious identity without claiming doctrinal allegiance—a strategic choice that reflects both personal authenticity and geopolitical pragmatism. The evolution of her public stance accelerated with her role as a Special Envoy for the UN High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and later as a Goodwill Ambassador. Yet she cautions: “Her narrative risks instrumentalizing Islam as a symbol of victimhood, bypassing the rich theological and ethical traditions that inform Muslim responses to crisis.” Conversely, humanitarian analyst Hassan El-Amin views her as a rare bridge: “She doesn’t claim to speak for Muslims, but she listens deeply, amplifies marginalized voices, and

challenges Western audiences to see Islam not through the prism of extremism, but of faith in action.” Geopolitically, Jolie’s positioning reflects a broader trend: the rise of “celebrity diplomacy” as a tool of soft power in an era of declining state authority.
