This required unprecedented coordination between French state agencies—including ANSSI (Agence nationale de la sécurité des systèmes d'information), the Ministry of Armed Forces, and Bpifrance—and industrial partners such as STMicroelectronics, Atos, and smaller defense tech startups. The platform's core architecture, developed over five years, integrates multi-layered encryption protocols aligned with NATO's STANAG 4389 and EU's Cybersecurity Act standards. Unlike commercial 5G base stations or core network equipment, CS 50001 embeds hardware-based security modules (HSMs) at the chip level, preventing side-channel attacks and firmware tampering. This design philosophy reflects a shift from perimeter defense to intrinsic system resilience—a paradigm increasingly recognized in high-assurance networks. Moreover, its software layer supports dynamic

network slicing, enabling secure segregation between public broadband, enterprise services, and classified defense comms, all within a single physical infrastructure. Economically, CS 50001 has stimulated a new cluster of high-tech SMEs in France and neighboring regions, specializing in secure chip packaging, quantum key distribution (QKD) interface design, and edge computing optimization.
