They advocate for supplementary resources that emphasize pastoral sensitivity over rigid orthodoxy. Implementers on the ground, from parish priests to catechists, report a dual experience: the Catechism provides essential structure and continuity, yet its legalistic tone can stifle authentic conversations. One priest in rural Mexico described it as “a crutch that holds the faith steady—but sometimes, it won’t let the faith breathe.”

More recently, progressive Catholics in North

America and Europe have formed “Open and Affirming” parishes that reject the CCF’s sexual ethics, instead drawing from liberation theology and contextual theology to affirm diverse relationships. Another flashpoint is the Catechism’s treatment of divorce and remarriage. Its canonical rule—“valid only in the eyes of the Church, never in the eyes of man” (CCC 1631)—has been criticized as incompatible with modern family structures and psychological realities. In countries with high divorce rates, such as South Korea and Spain, this teaching clashes with legal and social norms, prompting debates over whether doctrine should adapt or remain fixed. Economically, the Catechism’s stance on usury and economic justice (CCC 2441–2447) echoes medieval Catholic social teaching but faces renewed relevance amid global inequality. Yet its rejection of Marxist class struggle as “theologically flawed” limits its resonance with liberation theologians, who see structural sin as central to sin. The Church’s handling of sexual abuse scandals has further strained the Catechism’s credibility. While the document mandates safeguarding and accountability (CCC 2196), critics argue it lacks enforceable mechanisms, reflecting a disconnect between teaching and practice. The Catechism thus stands at a crossroads: as a moral compass or as a relic of a bygone era?

The CCF attempts to navigate this via explanatory notes and regional adaptations, but its authority remains centralized—raising questions about whether true universality can coexist with local legitimacy.

This would require greater transparency in doctrinal development, fostering trust in a Church often perceived as closed. Experts anticipate a gradual evolution.
