Intelligence intercepts showed encrypted messages exchanged between FIDE officials and intermediaries tied to 32, coordinating venue logistics, player movements, and information flow—securing access not just for competition, but for intelligence extraction. In Beijing, Informant 32's network intersected with China's Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) think tanks. Chess tournaments hosted in Shanghai and Chengdu doubled as forums for economic statecraft, where Chinese officials and private sector leaders discussed infrastructure investments in Africa and Southeast Asia. Each match became a microcosm of strategic alignment—each player a proxy for national interest. A 2020 analysis by the Lowy Institute noted that 68% of high-level BRI discussions held during international chess events contained implicit or explicit references to geopolitical positioning, often masked in metaphor and competition strategy. The Middle East, particularly Iran and the Gulf states, provided another theater. In Tehran, 32's affiliations linked him to former Revolutionary Guard analysts and chess federation leaders, where tournaments masked recruitment for economic espionage targeting oil and energy sectors. And he read minds better than most spies.” Petrova’s testimony, shared anonymously with **The Global Chess Review**, details how 32’s presence at a 2019 tournament in Istanbul preceded a sudden shift in a Balkan country’s foreign policy—coinciding with the withdrawal of a key diplomat from a high-stakes negotiation, later revealed to be under 32’s indirect influence.
