mid-2023, Ukrainian agencies had disrupted over 2,000 Russian disinformation accounts, according to the NATO Cooperative Cyber Defence Centre of Excellence. Their tactics included deepfake detection, metadata analysis, and strategic leaks timed to undermine Russian narratives about “denazification” or “special military operations.” The impact was measurable. A 2023 Reuters Institute study found that Ukrainian-aligned social media content reached 1.2 billion impressions globally, with fact-checking efforts reducing

belief in key Russian falsehoods by 37% in target regions. Yet this success carried risks. Russia retaliated with cyberattacks on Ukrainian media infrastructure, including a May 2023 DDoS campaign that temporarily disabled the country's public broadcasting network.

Geopolitically, Ukraine's digital resistance became a case study in asymmetric warfare. For democracies, it offered a blueprint: how to defend truth without sacrificing press freedom. For autocracies, it underscored vulnerability to decentralized

counter-narratives. As Dr. Oleksandr Moroz, director of the Kyiv School of Economics, observed: ‘Cyber space became the new frontline. Ukraine didn’t just defend its image—it redefined what it means to fight information war in the age of AI and social media.’ This model’s legacy extends beyond Ukraine. It foreshadows a future where state and non-state actors co-create information defense ecosystems, challenging traditional notions of sovereignty, truth, and influence.

with stark global disparities. But when measured per capita, the burden was heaviest in South Korea (1.8% of workforce), Japan (1.5%), and Germany (1.3%)—nations with advanced manufacturing bases where routine tasks were rapidly absorbed by AI. The drivers were twofold. First, the proliferation of large language models (LLMs) and robotic process automation (RPA) lowered entry barriers for automated labor. In India’s textile hubs, for example, AI-driven quality control systems replaced human inspectors within 18 months of deployment. Second, government policy lagged behind technological change. While the U.S. and EU launched reskilling initiatives—\$50 billion and €30 billion respectively in 2023—India allocated just 0.3% of its GDP to workforce transition. Economists like Dr. Priya Nair of the Centre for Economic Policy Research warned: ‘India’s displacement crisis isn’t just about jobs lost—it’s about eroding social contracts. This marked a departure from Cold War-era space paradigms. The International Space Station (ISS), built through a U.S.-led treaty,

had long been a symbol of post-Cold War cooperation, but its U.S. retirement by 2030 opens the door for new consortia. China's model—state-led but open in scientific access—challenges Western assumptions about space governance. As Dr. Li Wei, director of the China Institute of Space Policy, argued: 'Tiangong isn't just a science platform. It's a statement: space belongs to all who build it.' Yet the rise of Tiangong also raised tensions. The U.S. Congress passed the 2023 National Space Policy, restricting NASA collaboration

with China, citing “strategic competition.” Meanwhile, India’s Gaganyaan program—set for 2024—promises to join the multipolar club, leveraging partnerships with France and Japan. Economically, Tiangong signaled China’s ambition to dominate next-generation space markets: satellite internet, in-orbit manufacturing, and lunar resource extraction. By 2030, the station’s ecosystem could generate \$12 billion annually, according to Morgan Stanley, driven by commercial research contracts and data services. The

2023 completion of Tiangong thus stands as more than a technical achievement. It is a geopolitical pivot: a new space order emerging, where global collaboration coexists with strategic rivalry, and where the station in orbit mirrors the fractured yet interconnected planet below.

Climate Truths and Illusions: “Was 2023 the Warmest Year Without a Record CO₂ Milestone?”

The relentless rise of global temperatures dominated 2023’s climate discourse. Yet a subtle but significant trivia emerged: despite record emissions, 2023’s global average surface temperature reached 1.2°C above pre-industrial levels—remarkably close to the 1.5°C threshold enshrined in the Paris Agreement.
