In the U.S., CNAs earn median hourly wages between \$14–\$18, yet high turnover (estimated at 40–60% annually) signals systemic underinvestment. "It's a necessary barrier," says union spokesperson Maria Lopez, "but it must not obscure systemic underfunding. When wages stagnate and training is outsourced to underresourced programs, the exam becomes a test of survival, not skill." This tension underscores a paradox: the exam elevates professionalism while exposing structural failures in workforce support.

Controversies and Risks: Competence vs. Access The exam is not without controversy. Critics point to high failure

The World Health Organization (WHO) has endorsed nurse assistant frameworks since 2018, recognizing their role in universal health coverage (UHC) goals. In Rwanda, post-genocide health reforms integrated community health assistants (CHAs) with similar competency structures, reducing maternal mortality by 34% in five years. CHAs there are trained in basic obstetrics, HIV care, and mental health first aid—mirroring the U.S. focus on multidimensional readiness. Yet significant divergence persists. In India, the

National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) regulates “Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Assistants,” but CNAs are not formally certified; instead, frontline workers receive on-the-job training with minimal national oversight. Brazil’s Sistema Único de Saúde (SUS) uses a hybrid system: regional councils design localized exams, blending national standards with cultural context—such as indigenous health protocols. These models contrast with the U.S.’s top-down standardization, suggesting that adaptability, not uniformity, enhances effectiveness.
