A 2021 study in Manila found that 12% of

This has led to recalls in some markets, such as a 2019 incident in Jakarta where 500 units were tested for frame fatigue. The manufacturer responded with enhanced heat-treatment protocols and mandatory user training via QR-coded manuals, blending tradition with digital literacy. Regulatory friction compounds these risks. In Mumbai, municipal codes classify all retractable canopy systems as 'temporary structures,' requiring permits that informal vendors cannot obtain. This

forces many to operate illegally, exposing both users and operators to liability during monsoon-related collapses. Activists argue that policy must evolve—'Not criminalize adaptation, but enable it through inclusive urban codes.' There is also a growing debate over environmental sustainability. **While Jekito's low-tech design reduces energy use, polyvinyl fabric is not biodegradable and contributes to microplastic pollution when discarded. Some manufacturers are experimenting with recycled HDPE mesh and plant-based coatings, but adoption is slow due to cost and supply chain constraints.**
