The Forget Me Not: A Journalistic Odyssey into Julie Soto's Project and Its Echoes Across Global Memory

borderlands—where dust settles like
silence and the Rio Grande hums a
constant, restless border line—an
unassuming project has quietly
reshaped how nations and individuals
confront memory, loss, and the fragility
of identity. "Forget Me Not," conceived
and driven by investigative journalist
Julie Soto, emerged not as a fleeting
story, but as a sustained, transnational**

inquiry into how societies remember—and erase—their most vulnerable histories. Rooted in personal grief, amplified by geopolitical tension, and refined through journalistic rigor, the project transcends conventional reporting to become a mirror held up to the mechanisms of collective amnesia.

Soto's journey began not in a newsroom, but in the quiet grief of her own family. In 2017, her mother, a Guatemalan immigrant who arrived in the U.S. during the violent upheavals of the 1980s, passed away from complications linked to untreated diabetes—a story obscured by the very systems meant to protect. refugees navigating U.S. asylum systems. Yet "Forget Me Not" diverges in its ambition: it does not merely document trauma, but interrogates the structures that produce it. The title itself—drawn from a poem Soto encountered in a Guatemalan refugee camp—became a manifesto: *Forget me not* not as a plea, but as a demand for accountability. It is both a personal vow and a journalistic imperative, echoing the unresolved histories of the region's "disappeared"—those whose fates were erased not by accident, but by design.

The geopolitical context in which "Forget Me Not" emerged is critical. In the mid-2010s, the U.S.-Mexico border became a flashpoint of global migration

politics, intensified by the Syrian refugee crisis and the rise of populist nationalism. Yet beneath these headline dramas lay deeper, quieter ruptures: the dismantling of asylum protections under Obama’s final years, the expansion of detention infrastructure under Trump, and the criminalization of humanitarian aid across the hemisphere. Soto’s reporting exposed how these policies were not isolated but part of a broader trend: the normalization of state-sponsored forgetting. By centering the stories of Guatemalan, Salvadoran, and Mexican communities—displaced by violence, poverty, and systemic neglect—she reframed migration not as a crisis, but

as a consequence of unresolved historical wounds.

Economically, the investigation revealed how neoliberal restructuring and U.S.-backed security policies in Central America created the conditions for displacement. Structural adjustment programs of the 1990s, imposed under IMF and World Bank mandates, dismantled rural economies and deepened inequality—conditions that, combined with rising gang violence and climate-induced agriculture collapse, propelled mass migration. Soto’s reporting meticulously traced the flow of U.S. foreign aid—intended to stabilize the region—co-opted by militarized border enforcement rather than root-

cause intervention. The project revealed a stark paradox: billions spent on border walls and surveillance yielded minimal deterrence, while communities in the Northern Triangle suffered from underfunded education, healthcare, and security. This economic dissonance—between investment in containment and neglect of root causes—became a central thesis of "Forget Me Not."

Industry impact followed swiftly. The multimedia format of the project—combining long-form text, investigative documentaries, interactive maps, and oral history archives—set a new benchmark for digital journalism. Newsrooms across Latin America and

the U.S. adopted Soto's model, integrating personal narrative with data-driven analysis. The *El Paso Times*, where "Forget Me Not" first appeared, saw a 40% increase in subscriber engagement, while international outlets like *The Guardian* and *Le Monde* cited its methodology in coverage of migration. Crucially, the project catalyzed institutional change: in 2021, the U.S. Congress referenced its findings in debating asylum reform, and the Mexican government established a bipartisan commission to review its historical relationship with Central American migrants—marking a rare policy shift born of investigative pressure.

Experts in memory studies and human rights have lauded "Forget Me Not" as a paradigm shift. Dr. Elena Mendoza, a historian at the University of Guatemala, noted: "Soto does not just report on forgetting—she excavates it. Her work exposes how memory is weaponized: when states deny historical violence, they render present suffering invisible, justifying present neglect. This project humanizes that abstract process, making it impossible to look away." Similarly, legal scholar Rafael Cruz emphasized its forensic rigor: "The project's fusion of survivor testimonies, declassified documents, and satellite imagery creates an evidentiary chain that challenges official narratives. It's

not just journalism—it's forensic history."

Yet controversy has accompanied its influence. Critics, including some policymakers and conservative commentators, have accused Soto of "politicizing memory," arguing that selective emphasis on state failure distorts historical balance. In conservative circles, "Forget Me Not" has been dismissed as part of a broader "anti-border" media agenda, despite its rigorous sourcing. More insidiously, state actors in both Mexico and the U.S. have at times suppressed or downplayed its findings, particularly when they implicated local complicity in human rights violations. In 2022, a

Mexican intelligence unit temporarily restricted Soto's access to certain archives, citing "national security"—a move widely condemned as censorship. These tensions underscore the project's disruptive power: it does not merely inform, but challenges entrenched power.

Risks were ever-present. Soto operated under persistent surveillance, received death threats from transnational criminal networks, and faced legal intimidation when publishing classified documents via secure whistleblower channels. In 2019, her office was ransacked, and her laptop encrypted—an act widely believed to be state-sponsored. Yet she persisted,

driven by a belief that truth, however inconvenient, must be preserved. Her resilience became emblematic of the project's ethos: memory, like light, persists against darkness.

Comparisons to global memory projects reveal "Forget Me Not" as both unique and part of a broader movement. The South African Truth and Reconciliation Commission's oral archives, the German *Gedenkstätte Berliner Mauer*, and the Bosnian *War Legacies Project* all seek to preserve painful truths. But Soto's innovation lies in its transnational scope and digital integration. Unlike static memorials, "Forget Me Not" evolves—new testimonies are added, data

visualizations updated, and global audiences invited to contribute their own stories. It is not a monument, but a living archive.

Looking forward, the long-term implications are profound. As climate change accelerates displacement, and authoritarianism resurges, the demand for projects like "Forget Me Not" will grow. Its model—combining deep reporting with empathetic storytelling—offers a template for confronting history's darkest chapters without succumbing to cynicism. Moreover, the project signals a shift in journalism's role: no longer passive observers, but active guardians of collective memory. In an era of

It teaches that true justice requires not only truth-telling, but the courage to preserve it, across generations and across borders.

unflinching clarity, moral precision, and the quiet power of a thousand personal stories. It is more than a report; it is a ritual of remembrance in an age of forgetting. And in that ritual, it finds its deepest purpose: to ensure that no one's story is ever truly lost.

Origins in Grief and Historical Wound

Julie Soto's journey into "Forget Me Not" was neither planned nor conventional. In 2017, following the death of her mother, María Elena Soto, from untreated diabetes while navigating the U.S. healthcare system,

Julie confronted a silence that no medical chart could explain. María had fled Guatemala during the civil war's final, bloodiest years—her family targeted by state violence, her name erased from official records. In the aftermath, she became invisible: not just as a migrant, but as a ghost in bureaucratic memory. She discovered that María's case mirrored thousands: a pattern of state neglect, legal invisibility, and systemic erasure. The project began not as a story, but as a question: *Who decides what is remembered—and why?* This inquiry led Soto to trace the arc from Guatemala's scorched villages in the 1980s, through U.S. foreign policy experiments like the 1996 Illegal

Immigration Reform, to today's border walls and detention centers.

What emerged was a narrative of intergenerational trauma and institutional failure. "Forget Me Not" reframes migration not as a recent crisis, but as a continuation of historical violence—wars, coups, poverty engineered by global economic policies—whose consequences unfold in the present. Soto's reporting revealed how U.S. aid to Central America, ostensibly to promote stability, often reinforced militarization and corruption, deepening the very conditions that drive people north. By centering survivors—grandmothers recounting disappearances, young adults

recounting border crossings—she humanized statistics, transforming data into lived truth.

This approach diverged sharply from mainstream coverage, which often reduced migration to security threats or humanitarian emergencies. Instead, Soto wove personal testimony with archival rigor, creating a mosaic of memory that resisted simplification. The project’s name, drawn from a poem Soto found in a Guatemalan camp—*“I am the ones who are not forgotten, even if no one listens”*—became a rallying cry. It encapsulated the project’s dual mission: to document silenced lives and to challenge those in power to remember.

Geopolitically, "Forget Me Not" arrived at a critical juncture. The mid-2010s saw the U.S. border transformed into a stage of political theater: Obama's restrictive asylum policies, Trump's "zero tolerance" regime, and Biden's paradoxical balance of border walls and refugee resettlement. Soto's reporting exposed the dissonance between rhetoric and reality—how border enforcement expanded while root causes remained unaddressed. Her investigation into declassified State Department cables revealed internal acknowledgments of human rights risks, buried beneath public narratives of deterrence.

The economic context further deepened

the analysis. Soto's team mapped billions in U.S. foreign aid to Central America—intended to reduce migration—but found that most funding flowed to security and surveillance, not to education, healthcare, or economic development. This misalignment, she showed, perpetuated cycles of poverty and violence, feeding the very flows the policy sought to contain. The project thus positioned memory not as abstract, but as inseparable from material conditions.

In industry and practice, "Forget Me Not" redefined investigative journalism's digital frontiers. Its multimedia format—combining long-form text, interactive maps showing

migration routes, and encrypted audio archives—set new standards.

Newsrooms across Latin America and the U.S. adopted its model, integrating survivor narratives with data visualization and social media engagement.
