Central to this transformation are English learning books—physical and digital texts that serve as both pedagogical tools and cultural artifacts. These books, written in Urdu, are not mere translations; they are complex mediators of identity, aspiration, and geopolitical positioning. Their evolution reflects decades of post-colonial negotiation, economic pragmatism, and the relentless globalizing impulse. The origins of English learning materials in Urdu stretch back to the immediate aftermath of 1947, when the newly formed Pakistan inherited a fractured educational landscape. Urdu had been elevated to national language status, but English remained entrenched in higher education, civil service, and elite private schools. Early textbooks—often adapted from British colonial editions—were bilingual in intent but rarely in delivery. They retained colonial syntax and vocabulary, yet were repackaged in Urdu script to make them accessible. The first indigenous efforts emerged in the 1960s, led by pedagogues like Dr. Abdul Qadir, who recognized that rote learning of English grammar from foreign models failed to address the structural realities of Urdu-speaking learners. These early books emphasized

contextualized vocabulary—common phrases, local idioms, and practical dialogues—marking a critical departure from rigid colonial pedagogy. By the 1980s, a burgeoning middle class, fueled by economic liberalization and the expansion of private education, catalyzed a demand for more robust learning resources. Publishers such as Urdu Books International (a division of the state-linked publishing house) and private firms like Aqed Press began producing structured syllabi aligned with Cambridge and Cambridge English exams. These books introduced graded reading programs, listening exercises, and writing modules tailored to Urdu-speaking students. Crucially, they embedded cultural references—local proverbs, regional folklore, and socio-political contexts—making English not just a language of opportunity, but one rooted in lived experience. This shift mirrored a broader intellectual current: the reclamation of education as a tool for self-determination rather than passive imitation of Western norms. The geopolitical and economic context of Pakistan’s integration into global markets profoundly shaped the trajectory of English learning books. The 1990s saw a surge in outsourcing and IT services, positioning English as a strategic skill. Publishers responded by aligning curricula with international benchmarks—CEFR frameworks, TOEFL, and IELTS preparation—while maintaining Urdu as the medium of instruction. This dual-layered approach allowed learners to build fluency without abandoning linguistic identity. It

also reflected a deeper reality: English was no longer an elite privilege but an economic necessity. A 2005 study by the Pakistan Institute of Legislative Development and Transparency found that urban youth with proficiency in English were 3.2 times more likely to secure formal employment in multinational firms than their monolingual peers. Yet the industry's evolution was not without friction. Traditional educators and linguistic purists questioned the authenticity of Urdu-translated English books, arguing that they diluted native linguistic richness. Critics like Dr. Farhat Hashim, a linguist at Quaid-i-Azam University, warned that over-reliance on foreign grammatical structures risked producing "English that sounds foreign," limiting true communicative fluency. Others pointed to the uneven quality of publications—some driven by profit, others by pedagogy—creating a fragmented market where effective resources coexisted with superficial fillers. The dominance of private publishers, often incentivized by advertising and political connections, further complicated quality control. Despite these challenges, the market expanded exponentially. By 2020, Urdu-language English learning books constituted a multi-million-dollar industry, with digital platforms like EnglishPlus and UrduEnglish Hub leading a migration toward interactive learning. These platforms integrated AI-driven feedback, voice recognition, and adaptive learning paths—technologies that personalized education but also deepened concerns

about data privacy and algorithmic bias. The Urdu-English pedagogical ecosystem thus became a battleground of tradition and innovation: on one side, the value of localized, culturally embedded learning; on the other, the allure of global scalability and technological efficiency. Expert perspectives reveal a nuanced consensus. Dr. Ayesha Malik, director of the Institute for Language and Society, notes: “English in Urdu is not a colonial relic but a hybrid language in motion. The learning books that survive are those that recognize this hybridity—not as compromise, but as a fertile ground for authentic communication.” She emphasizes that the most effective materials balance grammatical accuracy with cultural resonance, enabling learners to code-switch fluidly between contexts. Conversely, Dr. Rashid Ahmed, a former examiner for Cambridge International, cautions: “Without rigorous standards, we risk producing a generation fluent in formulae but not in expression—users of English without ownership.” Controversies persist, particularly around access and equity. While urban centers boast a dense network of tutoring centers and digital resources, rural and low-income communities face severe shortages. A 2023 UNESCO report highlighted a 78% gap in English proficiency between urban and rural youth, with learning books often inaccessible due to cost or distribution. Women, though increasingly the primary learners, encounter additional barriers—social norms, limited mobility, and underrepresentation in publishing

content. Yet grassroots initiatives, such as community libraries in Sindh and Punjab supported by NGOs, are challenging these disparities, using mobile book units and peer tutoring to bridge the divide. The global comparison underscores both uniqueness and convergence. In India, English learning materials follow a similar bilingual model but with greater emphasis on regional language co-existence. In the Middle East, similar publishing ecosystems thrive, often with stronger state backing and standardized curricula. Indonesia and Nigeria exhibit parallel patterns—English books in local languages as tools for upward mobility, yet with distinct sociolinguistic textures. What sets Pakistan’s trajectory apart is its deep integration of Urdu as both container and conduit: a language that resists erasure, even as it absorbs global linguistic flows. Looking ahead, several trajectories emerge. First, the digital transformation will continue accelerating. AI tutors, immersive VR classrooms, and gamified learning apps promise personalized, scalable education—but only if infrastructure and inclusion are prioritized. Second, demand for localized, context-sensitive content will grow, driven by learners who reject one-size-fits-all models. Third, the boundary between English and Urdu will blur further: hybrid texts, code-meshing narratives, and bilingual pedagogies will redefine what “English learning” means in a post-colonial, post-digital world. Economically, English literacy remains a key determinant of social mobility. The World Bank projects

that by 2030, over 60% of Pakistan's workforce will require intermediate English proficiency to participate in high-value sectors. Urdu learning books, therefore, are not just educational tools but instruments of national development—key nodes in a chain linking individual agency to collective progress. Yet long-term sustainability hinges on systemic reform. Policymakers must invest in teacher training, curriculum standardization, and public-private partnerships that prioritize quality over quantity. Publishers, in turn, must resist commercial shortcuts and embrace collaborative innovation—drawing on linguists, educators, and learners to co-create materials that reflect lived reality. The story of English learning books in Urdu is ultimately the story of a society negotiating its place in a global order while preserving its linguistic soul. These books are more than pedagogical tools; they are vessels of aspiration, resilience, and reinvention. As Pakistan—and the broader Global South—navigate the complexities of the 21st century, the language learners armed with these texts may well become the architects of a more equitable, multilingual future.

The genesis: colonial legacy and the birth of Urdu-English pedagogy

The roots of English learning books in Urdu lie in the

colonial administration's educational engineering, which imposed English as the language of governance, law, and higher learning. Yet even under British rule, Urdu remained the dominant vernacular, spoken by millions across the subcontinent. The disconnect between colonial language policy and local linguistic practice created a fertile ground for pedagogical innovation. By the early 20th century, Urdu-educated intellectuals like Muhammad Iqbal and Allama Muhammad Iqbal began advocating for a modernized Urdu that could engage with global ideas—not through direct translation, but through synthesis. Though not educators of English, their vision inspired a generation of teachers to imagine English not as a foreign imposition, but as a tool for indigenous expression. The first formal attempts at English instruction in Urdu emerged in the 1930s, primarily through missionary schools and elite private institutions. These early texts were often abridged versions of British syllabi, rendered into Urdu script but retaining colonial linguistic norms. The 1947 partition intensified the urgency: Pakistan needed a unified education system, but Urdu was both a unifying symbol and a logistical challenge. The Ministry of Education's 1950s initiatives promoted "Urdu-English bilingualism," introducing simplified grammar, local idioms, and topic-based reading lists. Textbooks like 'English for Urdu Speakers' (1954), published by the Board of Intermediate Education, became foundational. They emphasized practical communication—ordering food, writing letters,

participating in meetings—over rote memorization, marking a shift toward functional literacy. This pedagogical experimentation reflected broader societal tensions. The elite feared that English would alienate youth from Urdu culture; the masses saw English as a ladder to modernity. Educators like Malik Ilham, a pioneer in Urdu-medium education reform, argued that English could be learned without abandoning Urdu: “Language is not a battlefield. It is a bridge.” His 1961 treatise, ‘English in the Urdu Classroom,’ advocated for gradual immersion, using Urdu as the anchor for grammar and vocabulary, with English introduced through contextual dialogue. Though initially met with resistance, his model gained traction by the 1970s, especially in urban centers where economic opportunity increasingly demanded English fluency.

The industrialization of learning: publishers, exams, and market forces

The 1980s and 1990s witnessed the professionalization of English learning books in Urdu, driven by both demand and deregulation. The State Publishing Corporation, alongside private firms, began mass-producing standardized textbooks aligned with international frameworks. The rise of competitive exams—CAT, IELTS,

TOEFL—created a commercial incentive to produce materials that guaranteed test success. Publishers invested in test-prep modules, listening banks, and pronunciation guides, often collaborating with foreign institutions for content validation. This era also saw the emergence of distinctive publishing strategies. Aqed Press, for instance, introduced graded readers titled ‘Urdu English Pathways,’ featuring local settings—marketplaces, colleges, government offices—to ground vocabulary in familiar contexts. Urdu Books International, backed by government contracts, developed teacher’s manuals with lesson plans, classroom activities, and assessment rubrics, professionalizing English instruction in public schools. These materials were not neutral; they reflected a market-driven logic where content was optimized for exam performance and classroom efficiency. Yet this industrialization brought contradictions. While quality improved, so did fragmentation. Regional publishers often prioritized profit over pedagogy, leading to a proliferation of low-cost, low-quality books with repetitive drills and outdated examples. The dominance of private publishers, many with political ties, raised concerns about content bias and lack of transparency. Meanwhile, digital technologies began seeping into the market: by the late 1990s, audio cassettes and VHS tapes supplemented textbooks, offering pronunciation practice and listening exercises. However, access remained limited to urban elites, deepening the urban-rural divide in English

proficiency.

Geopolitical undercurrents: English as a tool of soft power and economic integration

English learning books in Urdu cannot be divorced from Pakistan’s geopolitical positioning. The Cold War era saw English framed as a language of modernity and alignment with Western democracies, yet post-2000, the rise of India’s IT sector and China’s Belt and Road Initiative reshaped strategic priorities. English became not just a skill, but a geopolitical asset—critical for foreign investment, diplomatic engagement, and participation in global value chains. The 2000s privatization wave, supported by IMF and World Bank structural adjustments, accelerated this shift. With public education budgets strained, private publishers filled the gap, creating a competitive landscape where innovation was both incentivized and constrained. English books were repackaged as “global citizenship” tools, blending language instruction with soft skills like critical thinking, teamwork, and digital literacy—frameworks influenced by Western educational models. This alignment with global norms, however, sparked debates about cultural authenticity. Critics argued that Urdu-English books often imported Western cultural references—fast food, urban

nightlife, individualism—without adequate local anchoring. Others, like Dr. Farhat Hashim, countered that such exposure was inevitable and necessary: “Language evolves through contact. These books don’t erase Urdu; they expand its capacity to express modern realities.” Still, the tension between global competitiveness and local identity remains a defining challenge.

Expert voices: pedagogy, equity, and the future of language learning

Scholars and practitioners emphasize that the effectiveness of English learning books in Urdu hinges on more than content—it depends on delivery, context, and inclusivity. Dr. Ayesha Malik, director of the Institute for Language and Society, highlights: “The best books don’t just teach grammar. They teach learners how to navigate conversations, assert themselves, and interpret cultural cues. That’s the real marker of success.” She advocates for curricula that integrate sociocultural competence, enabling learners to code-switch with confidence across formal and informal settings. Yet systemic barriers persist. UNESCO’s 2023 report notes that only 38% of public schools in rural Punjab and Sindh have consistent access to English learning materials. Teacher training remains uneven—many educators themselves learned English

through exam-focused systems and lack confidence in adaptive teaching. Moreover, gender disparities endure: girls in conservative areas often face greater social resistance to English study, limiting their access to economic opportunities. Digital platforms offer partial solutions. EnglishPlus, a leading online provider, reports a 400% user increase since 2020, with mobile-friendly apps offering personalized lessons, speech recognition, and community forums. But digital access is uneven: rural connectivity, device affordability, and digital literacy remain significant hurdles. As Dr. Rashid Ahmed warns, “If we jump too quickly to digital, we risk leaving behind the learners who need these resources most.”

Controversies, risks, and the path to equity

The dominance of commercial publishers has sparked ethical concerns. Some books include hidden sponsorships, promotional content, or curriculum mandates that align more with corporate interests than educational needs. The 2018 scandal involving a major publisher falsifying exam-passing
