During the HIV/AIDS crisis, Kenya became a frontline in global health activism, attracting substantial foreign aid—over USD \$5 billion between 2000 and 2020—much of which flowed into university medical faculties. For medical students, the KES 150,000 annual fee represents a 15–20% annual burden, comparable to elite private universities but justified by anticipated earnings—median annual salaries for Kenyan doctors hover around KES 80,000–120,000, with specialists earning significantly more. This cost-benefit calculus drives enrollment patterns: while domestic intake has expanded, particularly from rural counties, drop-out rates remain high (estimated at 22% over five years), largely due to financial stress, academic pressure, and the psychological toll of debt. Expert analysis reveals deeper tensions. Dr. Jane Wambui, a public health economist at the University of Nairobi, notes: ‘The fee structure reflects a paradox—Kenya invests in human capital but penalizes the very students from whom healthcare systems depend.
