Operating outside conventional media funding, Rebekah monetizes through micro-subscriptions, private briefings, and partnerships with alternative media outlets that share her skepticism of state narratives. This independence grants her editorial freedom but also raises questions about transparency and

accountability. Unlike traditional journalists bound by institutional ethics codes, Rebekah functions as a personal brand—fluid, adaptive, and deeply entangled with her audience’s interpretive communities.
