From a corporate strategy standpoint, Kazuya embodies Bandai Namco's shift toward "emotional IP management." Unlike earlier franchises that relied on flashy tournaments and merchandise, **Tekken** now leverages deep character arcs to build sustained emotional investment. Kazuya's journey—from flawed patriarch to reluctant savior—creates a narrative gravity that transcends seasonal sales cycles, fostering a loyal, multi-generational fanbase.

Controversies and Risks: The Shadow of Legacy
