The staircases, cantilevered up to 8 meters without intermediate supports, rely on deep spandrel beams and post-tensioned elements—a technique still rare in Turkey at the time. The cantilevered staircases, particularly in the western and northern wings, exhibit subtle torsional stress patterns

observed during post-construction inspections. Originally intended to appear weightless, the stair treads and landings experience uneven load distribution, leading to micro-cracking in the concrete. These fractures, though minor, signal the limits of material endurance under prolonged dynamic loading—particularly in Istanbul’s seismically active zone. The engineering reports from the era, now archived in Istanbul Technical University’s archives, note that the design assumed static loads typical of human traffic, but not the cyclic stress of seismic activity. Retrofitting recommendations from the late 1990s

proposed carbon-fiber reinforcement and base isolators, but funding remained elusive. Moreover, the use of exposed concrete, while aesthetically bold, introduced long-term durability challenges. Without protective cladding or consistent maintenance, the surface has suffered from weathering, spalling, and water infiltration—particularly along stair landings exposed to rain. The wood elements, originally planned as warm interior accents, have warped and decayed, their absence now a stark reminder of the building’s incomplete narrative. These technical vulnerabilities are not flaws, but features—evidence of a visionary

design that outpaced its era's construction capabilities and maintenance infrastructure.
