Yet, within niche circles—academic theology, progressive Christian circles, and spiritual retreat communities—Kendall's narrative sparked a reevaluation of spiritual authority. No longer solely vested in bishops or televangelists, spiritual credibility now included those who had undergone radical personal transformation in isolation.

**** Expert Perspectives: Theology, Psychology, and Risk****

Theologians approached Kendall's journey with cautious interest.
