In India, Christian youth meetings are monitored amid rising Hindu nationalism, turning worship into a subtle act of resistance. Preachers must thus balance spiritual courage with strategic caution, often embedding subversive hope in metaphor and story rather than direct confrontation. Globally, comparative analysis reveals divergent approaches. In sub-Saharan Africa, Easter youth sermons often integrate indigenous cosmologies, framing resurrection as continuity with ancestral wisdom and communal resilience. In contrast, in East Asia—where Christianity remains a minority faith—Easter messaging emphasizes intellectual engagement, with
