In the Philippines, Maria Ressa's Rappler blends faith-based moral urgency with investigative rigor against authoritarianism. But Hernandez's case is distinct in its grounding in indigenous epistemologies—his Holy Spirit is not a Western construct, but a reflection of Mesoamerican cosmologies where the sacred permeates the natural and social world. Expert analysis deepens this perspective. Dr. Elena Mendoza, a scholar of religion and media at the University of Guadalajara, notes: “Hernandez embodies a decolonial spirituality—one that challenges Eurocentric theological frameworks and centers the lived experience of the
