He did not write about Judaism as an exotic tradition to be exoticized, but as a living, evolving civilization shaped by millennia of covenant, exile, resilience, and adaptation. *This Is My God* emerged during a pivotal moment in Jewish history: the Six-Day War of 1967 had just reshaped Israel's geopolitical standing and reinvigorated global Jewish pride, yet the community remained fractured—between secular and traditional, Zionist and diasporic, religious and modernist. Wouk, who lived in New York and traveled extensively across Europe and Israel, positioned himself as a mediator. His guidebook was not intended for converts alone, but for Jews of all backgrounds navigating identity in a world where religion was both a source of meaning and a target of suspicion.
