However, this commercialization has sparked controversy: critics argue that profit motives distort sacred content, reducing nuanced theological discourse to soundbites. Legal battles over copyright and authenticity have erupted, particularly between traditional custodians and modern publishers, revealing deeper conflicts over who controls religious narrative in a pluralistic society.

Expert Perspectives: Scholarship, Controversy, and Authenticity

Academic engagement with the Maansrovar remains fragmented but increasingly urgent. Dr. Harjinder Singh, a Sikh studies scholar at Punjab University, notes: “The Maansrovar challenges the myth of Sikh scripture as monolithic. It is a palimpsest—layered with political pragmatism, local epistemologies, and contested memory.” For mainstream Sikh scholars aligned with the Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee (SGPC), however, the Maansrovar is viewed with suspicion; Dr. Kumar Singh, a senior SGPC archivist, states: “Any text outside the Guru Granth Sahib risks fragmenting our spiritual unity. We preserve the Guru's Word, not variants.”

This divide reflects a broader tension between tradition and modernity. Anthropologist Dr. Meera Mehta, whose fieldwork spans rural Punjab, documents how younger Sikhs engage the Maansrovar not as doctrine but as cultural identity. In her 2022 study, she observes: “For many, it’s not about theology but belonging. The Maansrovar echoes their ancestors—those who fought, suffered, and thrived in this land.
