Wilder later said she “understood the script before reading it,” recognizing in its lines the echoes of her own disintegration. The controversies surrounding her life extend beyond personal scandals. Her death on August 5, 1962, at age 36, remains shrouded in ambiguity. Officially ruled a drug overdose, the circumstances—her sleeping pills, the lack of forensic rigor, the secrecy of her final hours—have fueled decades of speculation.
