From an economic standpoint, the tarot’s rise aligns with the explosive growth of the global occult economy, now estimated at over \$100 billion, driven by digital platforms, influencer spirituality, and a generational shift toward experiential belief. The New Orleans set capitalized on this momentum by positioning itself at the intersection of heritage tourism and esoteric consumerism.
