In authoritarian or centralized media systems, trivia can be curated to reinforce state-endorsed knowledge—e.g., promoting national history or scientific achievements. Conversely, in open democracies, trivia often amplifies pluralism, including diverse perspectives and minority knowledge. The 2021 **Jeopardy!** special celebrating Latin American independence movements, featuring trivia co-developed with regional scholars, exemplified this: a global format elevating historically marginalized narratives, turning quiz boxes into platforms for inclusive memory. Moreover, trivia's global spread is shaped by economic asymmetries. Western franchises often license formats to emerging markets, but local producers adapt them to regional contexts—India's **Kaun Banega Crorepati?** (2000–present), inspired by **Who Wants to Be a Millionaire?**, replaced Western product questions with Bollywood references and cricket trivia, deepening cultural relevance. Such adaptations challenge cultural imperialism, enabling local media ecosystems to own and reshape global formats. Trivia thus functions as a microcosm of cultural exchange—simultaneously exporting and importing values. Its questions reveal power dynamics: who gets to define “knowledge,” who is included or excluded, and how learning is framed as individual or collective. As nations vie for cultural influence, trivia becomes a contested yet collaborative
