Ave Maria Gomez positioned *Voz Latina* at this intersection: covering U.S. border policies with moral gravity, amplifying Latin American theological movements like liberation theology’s revival, and linking faith-based resistance to broader struggles for climate justice and economic equity. Her 2016 exposé “Sacred Trust: The Hidden

Ledgers of Church Charities” detailed how millions in U.S. and European donations were funneled into border shelters and refugee resettlement programs, but with inconsistent oversight, sometimes exacerbating dependency or reinforcing paternalistic power dynamics.
