This global policy framework created a feedback loop: small farmers lost access to credit, insurance, and fair pricing, while agribusinesses gained leverage through patented seeds, proprietary irrigation technology, and exclusive contracts. González’s reporting revealed how this system functioned not through overt coercion, but through institutional inertia—regulatory capture, data opacity, and the normalization of corporate dominance in food governance.

Industry Disruption: The Rise of the Vertical Farm Aggregator and Empire
