He envisions a future where architectural codes are interoperable across borders, using blockchain for compliance tracking and AI for predictive risk modeling. The rise of “smart cities” will demand codes that integrate cyber-physical security—protecting not just bricks but data flows, sensor networks, and autonomous systems. Yet he remains skeptical of technological panaceas. “No algorithm can replace human judgment,” he writes. “The soul of security lies in design that serves people, not just protects them.” Economically, Wible foresees a rebalancing: as climate risks escalate, insurance premiums tied to code compliance will drive market adoption. Developers who invest early in resilient design will gain competitive advantage, while laggards face escalating liability.
