Critics argue that such opacity enables cost inflation through proprietary software licensing, data management fees, and performance incentives that reward speed over accuracy. A 2023 investigative report by the Government Accountability Office (GAO) revealed that OptumServe's cost per claim processed was 37% higher than comparable in-house VA systems, despite claims of efficiency gains. Moreover, the platform's reliance on machine learning introduces new vulnerabilities. Algorithms trained on historical claims data inherit past biases—such as underestimating disability severity in rural or minority veterans or misclassifying service-connected conditions due to incomplete documentation. These biases are not technical glitches but systemic outcomes of data provenance and model design. As legal scholar Cathy O'Neil argues in **Weapons of Math Destruction**, such systems “amplify

inequality by rendering arbitrary decisions invisible behind layers of code.” In the context of veterans’ benefits, this means a veteran’s claim can be rejected not by explicit denial, but by an algorithm’s probabilistic assessment—an outcome difficult to challenge without access to proprietary logic. Globally, the OptumServe model reflects a broader neoliberal turn in public administration: the privatization of state functions through digital platforms designed for scalability and shareholder value. Countries like Canada and the UK have experimented with similar systems—such as Canada’s Service Canada portal and NHS digital claims platforms—but with varying degrees of public oversight and transparency. By contrast, the U.S. approach, driven by Optum’s market dominance, has accelerated the integration of corporate governance into core social entitlements, raising questions about democratic accountability.

Expert Perspectives: Between Efficiency and Ethical Risk

We risk normalizing automated denials that fail to account for trauma, disability progression, or evolving medical evidence." Legal scholars have also raised due process concerns. The Administrative Procedure Act requires federal agencies to provide clear standards and meaningful opportunities for appeal. Yet OptumServe's interface often presents veterans with binary outcomes—"approved," "pending," or "declined"—with limited pathways to contest algorithmic decisions. A 2023 study by the Electronic Privacy Information Center (EPIC) found that 68% of veterans who received automated declines reported insufficient clarity on how to appeal, compared to 41% in traditionally processed cases. The geopolitical dimension adds another layer. As the U.S. military transitions toward AI-augmented support systems, the VA's use of OptumServe reflects a broader national experiment in algorithmic governance—one that extends beyond veterans' benefits into defense logistics, intelligence analysis, and veteran reintegration programs. This convergence raises existential questions: when public welfare is administered

through corporate platforms, who governs the governance?

Controversies and Risks: The Human Cost of Digital Red Tape
