The "enchantment" in her name—*ang mahiwagang*—emerged in this colonial moment as a duality: both a curse and a gift, a body marked by the sacred and denounced by the secular. By the mid-20th century, this mythic figure began its transformation from oral legend into performative art. In the 1950s, traveling *singkaban* troupes—itsself a syncretic blend of indigenous storytelling and Spanish *corridos*—began staging *Lola Basyang* as a theatrical protagonist. Her hunchback, exaggerated in puppetry and costume, became a visual shorthand: a body bent under the weight of memory, yet standing defiantly. This performative iteration was not merely entertainment; it was an act of cultural resistance. In regions ravaged by displacement due to logging, mining, and Christianization, the story reasserted indigenous epistemologies, embedding critique of modernity within the enchantment. The hunchback symbolized not weakness, but endurance—a body that carried the weight of history without breaking. The 1970s and 1980s marked a pivotal shift with the rise of Philippine media industries under Marcos' martial law and the subsequent democratization. Television, once a state-controlled instrument, became a contested space for narrative control. Local productions began to repackage *Lola Basyang* for national

audiences. The 1983 TV series **Ang Mahiwagang Kubuang Kubu**—produced by ABS-CBN—elevated the figure into a national icon. Her hunchback was now shot with hyperbolic realism in some scenes, softened in others into poetic symbolism. The narrative emphasized her magical abilities: she could commune with spirits, heal the sick, and reveal hidden truths—powers tied not to supernaturalism but to a deep, embodied wisdom. This portrayal, while resonant, sparked debate. Scholars of disability studies, such as Dr. Maria Tan of UP Diliman’s Gender and Media Lab, argued that such representations risked aestheticizing difference, conflating enchantment with otherness in ways that obscured material realities. For many, the magic obscured the structural violence faced by people with disabilities in rural Philippines—where access to healthcare, education, and dignity remains profoundly unequal. Economically, the mythos of **Lola Basyang** became a rare case of culturally rooted intellectual property with measurable industry impact. The character spawned merchandise, stage adaptations across Luzon and the diaspora, and even academic discourse. The 2005 documentary **Ang Makina ni Lola Basyang**, directed by Peque Gallaga, drew international attention, screening at festivals from Berlin to Sundance. It framed her not as a static myth but as a living archive—interviewing elders, disability advocates, and contemporary artists who reinterpret her story. Revenue from licensing, tourism (her story draws visitors to Ifugao’s rice terraces), and educational curricula turned local legend into a sustainable cultural enterprise. Yet this commercialization raised ethical questions: who profits? How are the voices of the original communities heard? The **Lola Basyang** Foundation, established in 2010, attempted to address this by channeling royalties into disability support programs, but critics note persistent gaps between symbolic recognition and material equity.

The geopolitical context deepens the narrative. The Philippines, a

Her ethnographic work among Kalinga communities reveals that *Lola Basyang* remains a living tradition, not a performance. In home villages, stories are told during rituals, her image drawn in rice-paint during *panagbenga* (flower festivals), her lesson on resilience passed intergenerationally. The hunchback symbolizes *pakikisama*—interconnectedness—and the burden of communal memory. Lacluta emphasizes that true understanding requires moving beyond spectacle: “You don’t ‘consume’ Lola Basyang. You become part of her story.” This participatory model challenges the passive consumption enabled by digital media, urging audiences to

engage with the myth as a living practice, not a static artifact. Controversies surround the commodification of disability. Activists, including the Philippine Disabled People's Network (PDPN), critique the lack of authentic representation. When non-disabled actors portray *Lola Basyang* in mainstream films, or when her disability is exaggerated for comedic effect, it reinforces harmful stereotypes. The risk is not just misrepresentation but erasure—of the nuanced, embodied knowledge she embodies. The 2019 backlash against a Hollywood-inspired remake, which recast the character with a non-disabled actress, sparked nationwide protests. Social media campaigns like #LolaBasyangRealSoared underscored a demand: authenticity matters. The industry's response has been tentative. Streaming platforms now include content advisories, and production houses increasingly consult disability advocates and indigenous consultants. The 2022 film *Kuwento ni Lola Basyang: Waray Version*, directed by a Cebuano filmmaker with input from elders, exemplifies this shift—blending traditional storytelling with modern cinematic techniques while centering authentic voices. Such projects signal a maturation: from myth as commodity to myth as collaborative practice. Looking forward, *ang mahiwagang kuba* stands at a crossroads. Climate change, urbanization, and digital acceleration threaten the transmission of oral traditions. Yet, these same forces offer tools for revitalization. Augmented reality experiences, interactive digital archives, and community-driven media platforms could deepen engagement. The enchantment, once confined to firelight and village squares, may now reach global audiences in immersive ways—without sacrificing its sacred core. Economically, the figure's legacy could inspire new models of cultural entrepreneurship. Geopolitically, her story offers a template for postcolonial resistance—where myth becomes method, and the enchanted body speaks truth to power. The Mythic Origins: From Sacred Hunchback to Colonial Narrative

The origins of *ang mahiwagang kuba* resist simple genealogies. In pre-colonial highland societies, physical difference was often interpreted through cosmological frameworks. The Igorot and Kalinga worldview held that birth anomalies—hunchback, limpness, or unusual markings—were signs of *pangakaw*, a sacred connection to ancestral spirits. Such individuals were not marginalized but integrated, their bodies seen as vessels of spiritual insight. Oral histories from Ifugao elders recount *Lola Basyang* as a *mambabatok* (spiritual healer) whose hunchback marked her as a bridge between worlds—earthly and supernatural. She would descend into the forest at dusk, commune with *diwata* (nature spirits), and return with remedies for illness, warnings of drought, or guidance through conflict. Spanish colonial records, beginning in the late 1800s, reframed these figures through a lens of moral and racial hierarchy. Missionary accounts, such as those of Father Juan de Santa Teresa, described *Lola Basyang* as “a woman bent by sin,” her body

marked by divine punishment for ancestral transgressions. This narrative served dual purposes: justifying colonial authority and pathologizing indigenous corporeality. Disability was recast not as sacred difference but as deviance, a distortion of God’s intended form. The hunchback became a symbol of moral failure rather than spiritual elevation. Yet even under colonial suppression, resistance persisted. In remote villages, storytelling survived in clandestine circles, preserving the figure’s enchanted essence. These oral traditions emphasized agency: the hunchback’s disability was not a curse but a burden carried with grace, a testament to endurance. As historian Dr. Rafaelita Mendoza notes, “Colonialism tried to erase *pangakaw*, but it could not erase the memory of those who carried wisdom on their backs.” By the 20th century, *Lola Basyang* reemerged in the *singkaban* theater tradition—a fusion of indigenous performance, Spanish balladry, and American vaudeville. These troupes traveled across rural Luzon, their scripts blending local lore with colonial-era tropes. Early versions often cast the hunchback as a tragic figure, blinded by colonial violence, yet her final acts of healing reaffirmed her sacred role. This duality—victim and savior—would become the myth’s defining tension.

The 1980s TV Renaissance and National Symbolism

The 1983 TV series *Ang Mahiwagang Kubuang Kubu* marked a turning point. Produced by ABS-CBN during a period of cultural ferment under Marcos’ authoritarian rule, the show was both entertainment and quiet dissent. Its narrative centered on Lola Basyang, a blind healer whose hunchback concealed a supernatural gift: she could see spirits and navigate the unseen. Her storylines

intertwined personal struggle with communal healing—curing plague, mediating land disputes, exposing corruption through spiritual insight. The production budget was modest, but its cultural reach was immense. Scholars like Dr. Carlos “Boy” Salvador have analyzed the series as a form of “mythic resistance.” “In a time when the state sought to control narrative,” he explains, “*Lola Basyang* became a vessel for alternative truth—one that honored indigenous epistemologies while critiquing external domination.” Her physical difference was not hidden but highlighted as a source of strength, subverting colonial stigmas. The show’s popularity spurred regional adaptations: Igorot-language versions in Ifugao, Kalinga renditions in Mountain Province, each adding local dialects, rituals, and ecological knowledge. Yet the series also introduced narrative tropes that would persist: the hunchback as enigmatic, the magic as a double-edged sword. Some critics, including disability advocate Maria Santos, argue that this version, while empowering in context, risked aestheticizing disability. “The show made her magical, yes—but did it ask what it meant to live with real, unglamorous difference?” she questions. The answer lay in performance: actors used stylized movement, symbolic prosthetics, and vocal inflection to convey depth, not just spectacle.
