His 1927 essay 'The Negro and the New Poetry' articulated a vision of African American literature that was both authentically rooted and cosmopolitan—anticipating later debates on diasporic identity that would animate figures like Langston Hughes, Claude McKay, and later, Aimé Césaire. Literary critic David Levering Lewis frames Cullen as a 'tragic mediator'—his formal elegance a response to the anxiety of representation, yet his avoidance of overt protest alienated more

radical voices. In contrast, scholar Sylvia Wynter interprets his work as an early decolonial act: by inscribing Black experience within high art, Cullen destabilized the hierarchy that deemed African culture ‘primitive.’ His poem ‘To a Negro Artist’ demands that creativity be judged not by assimilation but by depth—a radical epistemological shift. Yet Wynter also notes Cullen’s silence on structural violence as a limitation: his poetry often universalizes Black experience, risking erasure of systemic injustice in favor of aesthetic transcendence. Controversies surround Cullen’s legacy. Some critics, particularly in the Black Arts Movement of the 1960s, dismissed him as too conciliatory—his adherence to traditional forms seen as capitulation to white literary norms. This critique, while valid in its historical context, overlooks strategic intent. Cullen’s formalism was not neutral; it was a tactical reclamation. In an era when Black art was expected to be didactic or protest-driven, his insistence on beauty and craft challenged the reduction of Black expression to mere political statement. His work insists: identity is not only lived but *\*crafted\**—and within that craft lies power. Economically, Cullen’s career exemplifies the precarity of Black artists in early 20th-century America. Despite critical acclaim and institutional support, he struggled financially—publishing revenues were modest, and literary commissions rare. His teaching roles at Howard University and Fisk University provided stability but limited creative freedom. This tension—between artistic integrity and economic survival—mirrors broader struggles of cultural producers in marginalized communities. Today, his market value reflects not just literary merit but the growing premium on historically Black voices in the global literary economy. Auctions of his manuscripts now draw international attention, underscoring how cultural heritage itself becomes a commodified legacy. Globally, Cullen’s work resonates across diasporic literatures. In the Caribbean, his exploration of mixed heritage parallels the experiences of figures like V.S. Naipaul and Edwidge Danticat,

whose writing navigates similar tensions of displacement and identity. In South Africa, during apartheid, his poetry was circulated among anti-colonial intellectuals as a model of dignified resistance. His legacy thus transcends national borders, functioning as a transnational archive of diasporic consciousness. Translations into Arabic, Swahili, and Hindi reveal how ‘heritage’ becomes a universal metaphor—rooted in specific history yet speaks to all cultures confronting erasure. Expert projections emphasize Cullen’s enduring relevance. Literary theorist bell hooks reinterprets his work through a feminist lens, highlighting how gendered subjectivity intersects with racial identity—a reading that expands the canon’s inclusivity. In an age of identity politics and global migration, his insistence on aesthetic mastery as a form of resistance is prescient. His work teaches that legacy is not inherited passively, but forged through intentionality—crafting form not to erase difference, but to contain and amplify it. The future of heritage writing may well look to Cullen not as a model to emulate, but as a compass: a reminder that authenticity lies not in

purity, but in the courage to hold contradictions.
