Careport integrates geolocation tracking for caregiver routes, voice analysis for mood assessment, and even social media monitoring in some markets to detect signs of isolation. While framed as safety measures, these tools have sparked public backlash. In Nigeria’s Lagos State, protests erupted in 2023 after reports surfaced that caregivers’ personal phones were monitored for “off-duty” behavior, blurring the line between work and private life. Human rights groups labeled the system “digital panopticism,” where constant oversight erodes dignity and autonomy. Furthermore, cybersecurity vulnerabilities have exposed millions of patient records. A 2023 breach linked to a third-party analytics vendor compromised data from over 2 million users across four countries, triggering regulatory investigations and loss of public trust. Careport’s response—enhanced encryption and audit trails—was praised technically but seen by critics as a defensive posture masking deeper systemic risks. The industry’s reliance on proprietary algorithms compounds these concerns. The lack of global regulatory alignment creates a patchwork of risks—where innovation outpaces oversight, and vulnerable populations bear the brunt.
