This dynamic mirrors broader debates about OTA power: while platforms democratize access, they also concentrate market control in algorithmic gatekeepers. From a regulatory standpoint, Trivago's Knoxville operations exist in a gray zone. The company complies with U.S. Federal Trade Commission guidelines on transparent pricing and disclosure, but its data-sharing
